#### **Round 1- APTITUDE**

In Aptitude round, the participants were shown questions on ppt projection. Each question was displayed for a minute. 30 questions ranging from general awareness, human resource to marketing

and finance were asked. Maximum scores for this round were 30. There were no negative marking and no eliminations. There were seventeen participants for this round.

#### **Round 2- COLLAGE.**

In this round, each participant was shown a slide of three unrelated pictures and was asked to speak relating them for 2 minutes. Seventeen participant were a part of this round. There was no elimination in this round. The event was judged by Ms Divya Mohan Rao, Faculty, R V Institute of Management and Mr Harsha K V. The participants were shown a case study and based on that, they had to take an ethical stand and answer the queries raised by the judges and the audiences while posing as the CEO. The participants were judged on criteria's like Communication, Knowledge and Situation Handling. In this round, 2 participants were eliminated and 4 were selected for final round.

After the inauguration, the event coordinator welcomed the participants for the finance event. All the participants were given the general instructions regarding the various rounds were conveyed and the first round began at 11.30.

#### **Round 1: Aptitude Test**

The round commenced at 11:30am .This round consisted of 70 questions the time limit given for completion of test was 45 minutes. The selected Questions from general awareness, numerical,

reasoning ability, banking, finance and accounting were asked. 1 mark was allotted for each question and no negative marks. At 12:15pm round 1 was completed. There was no elimination for this round. All teams progressed to the next round.

#### **Round 2: Juumbled Balance Sheet**

The second round was on Jumbled Balance Sheet and the round commenced at 12:30. Question includes list of jumbled assets and liabilities with values. A blank format of balance sheet was given. Time allotted was 10 minutes to complete the corrected balance sheet. Each answers identified was allotted with 1 mark and 2 marks for tallying the balance sheet.

After the completion of the first round and second round, the aggregate score was considered for elimination. The elimination was based on cumulative scores of both, the first round as well as the second round. Out of 22 teams only 11 teams progressed to the third round rest 11 teams were eliminated.

#### **Round 3: Cross word**

The third round commenced at 12:45 pm. A cross word related to finance and accounts words were given. The teams were provided with Across and Down details and were asked to identify the words. The time allotted for this round is 20 minutes. Each answer identified was allotted 1 mark each. The elimination was based on cumulative scores of the first round, second round as well as third round. Out of 11 teams participated, 6 progressed towards fourth round.

#### Round 4: Finanzas - Finance quiz

The round commenced at 1.15 pm. This round consisted of three sub rounds:

- 1. Dhyaan se dekho: A set of images were shown to teams and the teams were asked to connect these images and draw accounting or finance terms out of it. Each right answer was awarded with 10 points and no negative marking and no passing of questions were allowed. Time allotted was 30 sec for each question and each team was asked to answer 2 questions.
- 2. Rapid fire: The teams were asked to pick the chit and select the topic for the rapid fire round. The topics covered were on accounting, tax, insurance, finance, stock. A continuous set of questions was asked to teams asked on the topic selected. Time allotted -2 minutes for each team. Right answers were awarded with 20 points each. No penalty for wrong answers.
- 3. Lagao Boli: In this round, the teams were informed to pick a set of two chits and to bid on the questions numbers mentioned in the chits. Each team was asked to bid 50 points and the bidding should be in multiples of 10 points. In some chits bonus points were awarded and a 30 second time was allotted to answer for each question. No penalties for wrong answers.

The purpose of this quiz was to check the knowledge of the teams and their quickness in answering the questions on time. Elimination was based on cumulative scores of all 4 rounds and out of 6 teams only 4 teams were selected for the final round.

#### **Round 5: Investment plan**

The last round commenced at 2 pm. The selected teams were given 5 lakhs virtual money. Each team was asked to prepare an investment plan. They were asked to invest in various investment avenues. Further the teams were informed to calculate the returns and informed to show all the calculations as a part of the assignment. The investment was for next 1 year. All the teams were provided with The Economic Times for their reference and to collect the required data. Further the teams were forbidden to use the internet. The time allotted was 45 min for preparation and 10 min PPT and 2 min Q&A.

The purpose of this round was to test each team's problem solving, analytical, and communication skills. The external judges were asked to judge the event.

During commencement of final round judges were welcomed with bouquet and judges were thanked by giving the memento.

The teams were called one by one. The presentations were well prepared and the teams were competent enough to come up with good revival strategies. The judges put forth some insightful questions at the participants, who were able to justify their explanations. The round concluded at 4.15 pm. The judges then interacted with the participants, giving the participants inputs on finance and the various opportunities. They also gave general feedback on the performance of the participants. Feedback from the participants about the various events was collected.

Out of the 4 teams that presented in the finals only 2 teams went on to receive prizes. Team MICROSOFT from Christ College secured the first Place and Team Citibank from ITM College secured the second place.

Part 3: Jumbled words: 5 Jumbled words related to marketing concepts.

Part 4: Brief Introduction about 5 companies or brands was given. The participants had to identify the companies or Brands.

There were a total of 26 teams who participated in the first round. The scoring was done for this round out of 20, which is 1 mark per question. The time provided for this round was 20 minutes. Each logo was displayed for 30 seconds and the rest of the remaining time was provided to the participants to answer the rest of the 15 questions. There was no elimination for this round. All teams progressed to the next round.

#### Round 2: 'Use it well!'

#### Multipurpose usage of Products.

Each team was asked to pick chits, in which a unique product to each team was mentioned. The products were of the likes of belt, candle, hair band, etc. The team were required to make a list of multipurpose uses for the given product and also write a brief description of how the use of the product would be carried out in their perspective and write it down on the answer sheet in as little time as possible. The multipurpose uses had to be unique as well and creative. The practicalities of the uses were also given importance. The teams were given 10 minutes to write down as many uses as possible. This round carried 30 marks. Elimination of contestants was carried out. The

elimination was based on cumulative scores of both, the first round as well as the second round. Out of 26 teams, 14 teams were eliminated and 12 teams progressed to the third round.

#### Round 3: 'Mad Dash'

#### **Hard Sale**

All the participant teams, i.e. 12 teams, were allotted a volunteer per team. The volunteers were each given a key to the lockers on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. All the participant team members were requested to deposit their belongings such as mobile phones and wallets/ purses in the lockers. The participants were then asked to come forward to pick a chit on which was a number. Each numbered package made had an assortment of products. The products were of the likes of cucumber, incense sticks, vim bar, maggi noodles packet, etc. The basic task of each team was to sell the assortment of these products outside or within the college premises. All the teams were given the same base price of `35. The objective of each team was to sell the given products at whatever price possible, but with the intention of making a maximum profit margin and obtain the signature of their customer to validate the sale. The team with the maximum sale price would be given highest scores. The teams went outside the campus and were successful in selling all the products provided. 

After the inauguration, the event coordinator welcomed the participants for the finance event. All the participants were given the general instructions regarding the various rounds were conveyed and the first round began at 11.30.

#### **Round 1: Aptitude Test**

The round commenced at 11:30am .This round consisted of 70 questions the time limit given for completion of test was 45 minutes. The selected Questions from general awareness, numerical,

reasoning ability, banking, finance and accounting were asked. 1 mark was allotted for each question and no negative marks. At 12:15pm round 1 was completed. There was no elimination for this round. All teams progressed to the next round.

#### **Round 2: Juumbled Balance Sheet**

The second round was on Jumbled Balance Sheet and the round commenced at 12:30. Question includes list of jumbled assets and liabilities with values. A blank format of balance sheet was given. Time allotted was 10 minutes to complete the corrected balance sheet. Each answers identified was allotted with 1 mark and 2 marks for tallying the balance sheet.

After the completion of the first round and second round, the aggregate score was considered for elimination. The elimination was based on cumulative scores of both, the first round as well as the second round. Out of 22 teams only 11 teams progressed to the third round rest 11 teams were eliminated.

#### **Round 3: Cross word**

The third round commenced at 12:45 pm. A cross word related to finance and accounts words were given. The teams were provided with Across and Down details and were asked to identify the words. The time allotted for this round is 20 minutes. Each answer identified was allotted 1 mark each. The elimination was based on cumulative scores of the first round, second round as well as third round. Out of 11 teams participated, 6 progressed towards fourth round.

#### Round 4: Finanzas - Finance quiz

The round commenced at 1.15 pm. This round consisted of three sub rounds:

- 1. Dhyaan se dekho: A set of images were shown to teams and the teams were asked to connect these images and draw accounting or finance terms out of it. Each right answer was awarded with 10 points and no negative marking and no passing of questions were allowed. Time allotted was 30 sec for each question and each team was asked to answer 2 questions.




