
Ecosystem for Innovations

Innovations through novelty and need for the social innovation, was analyzed referring to existing models adopted in various Innovation Labs across the world. The university syllabus set by the Bangalore University was not just enough to teach the students creative thinking skills through hands on work approach. A separate lab for innovations was the need then. In order to sustain the pedagogical model and to cater to the needs of bottom of the pyramid a new approach inclined towards social innovation was imperative in the classroom teaching. The concept of The Fortune at the Bottom of the Pyramid originally appeared as an article by C. K. Prahalad and Stuart L. Hart and the concept of 'Reverse Innovation' proclaimed by Vijay Govindarajan was thought of to be the right approach. To advance our approach it was decided to set up an Innovation Lab in the Campus. An E mail communication to confirm the linkage between CSR and Reverse Innovation with Vijay Govindarajan brought in to design a curriculum for the newly thought 'Social Innovation Lab'. Vijay Govindarajan, known as VG, is widely regarded as one of the world's leading experts on strategy and innovation. VG, NYT and WSJ Best Selling author is the Coxe Distinguished Professor at Dartmouth College's Tuck School of Business. At that point of time in 2012, the course had to be offered as a Value Additional Programme to supplement existing Bangalore University syllabus as the up gradation of syllabus was not completed. In 2015 Bangalore University introduced a new syllabus with the subject 'Innovation Management' a theory paper with term end examination and with reduced teaching allotted time of 2 hours per week. Meanwhile communications with all the leading institutions and industry professionals continued to evolve feasible teaching methods with evaluative rubrics for measuring the outcome of the classroom instructions and laboratory exercises. To provide hands on training RVIM had established communication with 'Visvesvaraya Industrial and Technological Museum'. This training aims to make conditions as realistic as possible. Visvesvaraya Industrial and Technological Museum houses a wealth of knowledge with working models in all fields. The museum was in proximity to RVIM Campus around 7 Kms. RVIM was forerunner to initiate the concept of Social INNOVATION in B-School with an additional 2

hours of practical sessions incorporated as an extra teaching and practical session every week. This was made possible with the support of Head of The Institution and Time Table Committee.





Following this a series of communication was established with innovations lab to develop a measuring system through rubrics. This resulted in ultimately setting up of a Social Innovation Lab in RVIM Campus with existing Computer Lab access and a mandatory visit to Visvesvaraya Industrial and Technological Museum for real life experience. Added to this students were advised to commence their sessions on Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs). This MOOCs courses relating to Innovation and Design Thinking was a part of the students learning beyond the campus learning and during leisure and vacations. Students were encouraged to register for the MOOCs programme offered through Edx.

The additional 2 hours of Innovation Lab Session, Visit to Technological Museum and incorporation of Edx MOOCs learning platform provided a synergetic approach to inculcate necessary skills to move ahead and protect the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) FOR NEW INVENTIONS. Advancing the students thoughts to apply for Patents and Copyrights was laid. All necessary support for students to consult a Patent Attorney was encouraged. In case of social innovation ideas , contacts with Government agencies and NGOs were established to disseminate the ideas. Few students participated in Hackathon and other design contests offered through government portal https://www.mygov.in/

The RVIM Innovation Lab started in 2015 gradually gained acceptance among local community and academic circles.






Photograph- Colour coded sheet for data and working





Tracking Potential Patents to Recycle Abandoned Tyres




Understanding Students Learning Styles


E mail Image-2010 Result of learning style of a student with the best performance






E Mail Image-2012 Feedback provided to the student after the test


