



ages was a hard task," shared Anand.

"I got the topic 'mid-day meals' and since it was a technical topic, I had to organise my thoughts and use my time accordingly. I tried to narrate how these meals play a major role in promoting education in rural areas," she detailed.

Such events often leave an impression on students. Mallesh, a student who hails from Shimoga, expressed the need of more government schools in the City. "The government should make education accessible to all barring class and monitory divides in the society." he said. Inspired by the need of education for all, Rizwan, another student, said that he has decided to help train and take tuitions for students in his locality, who cannot afford extra

fees for the same. "Education should be open to all and everyone should be able to easily access it," he wrapped up. DHNS
