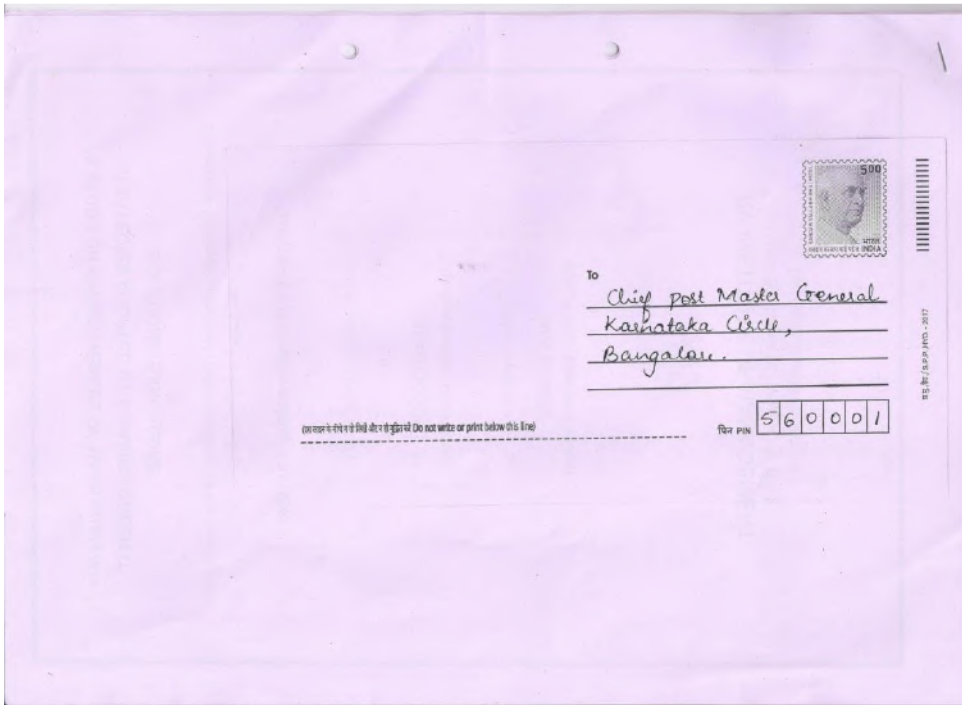
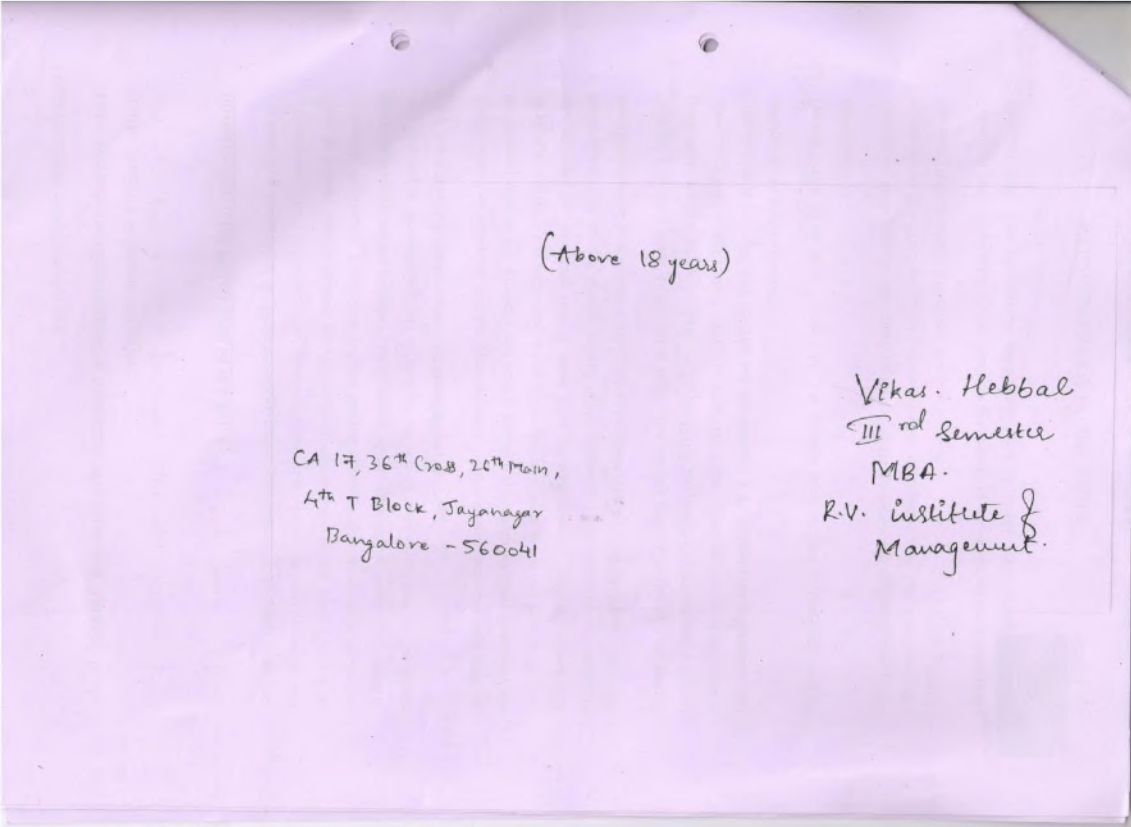
Dear Babuji

and increased my peaceful thought process.

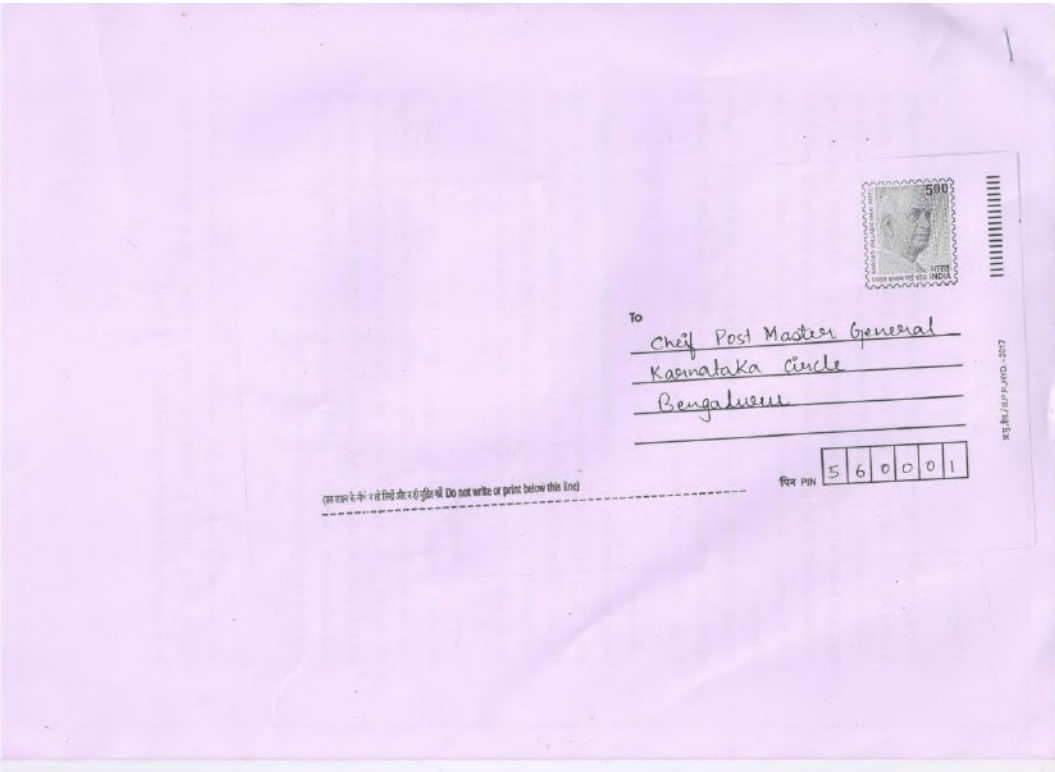
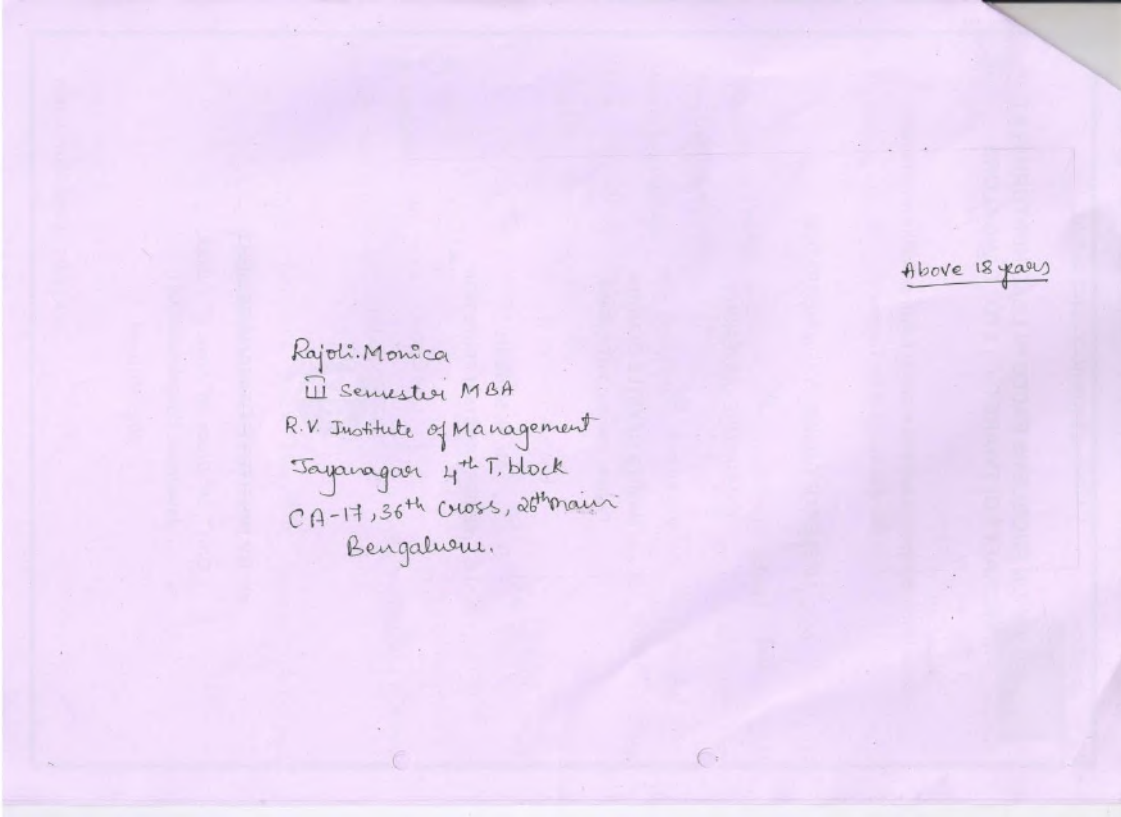

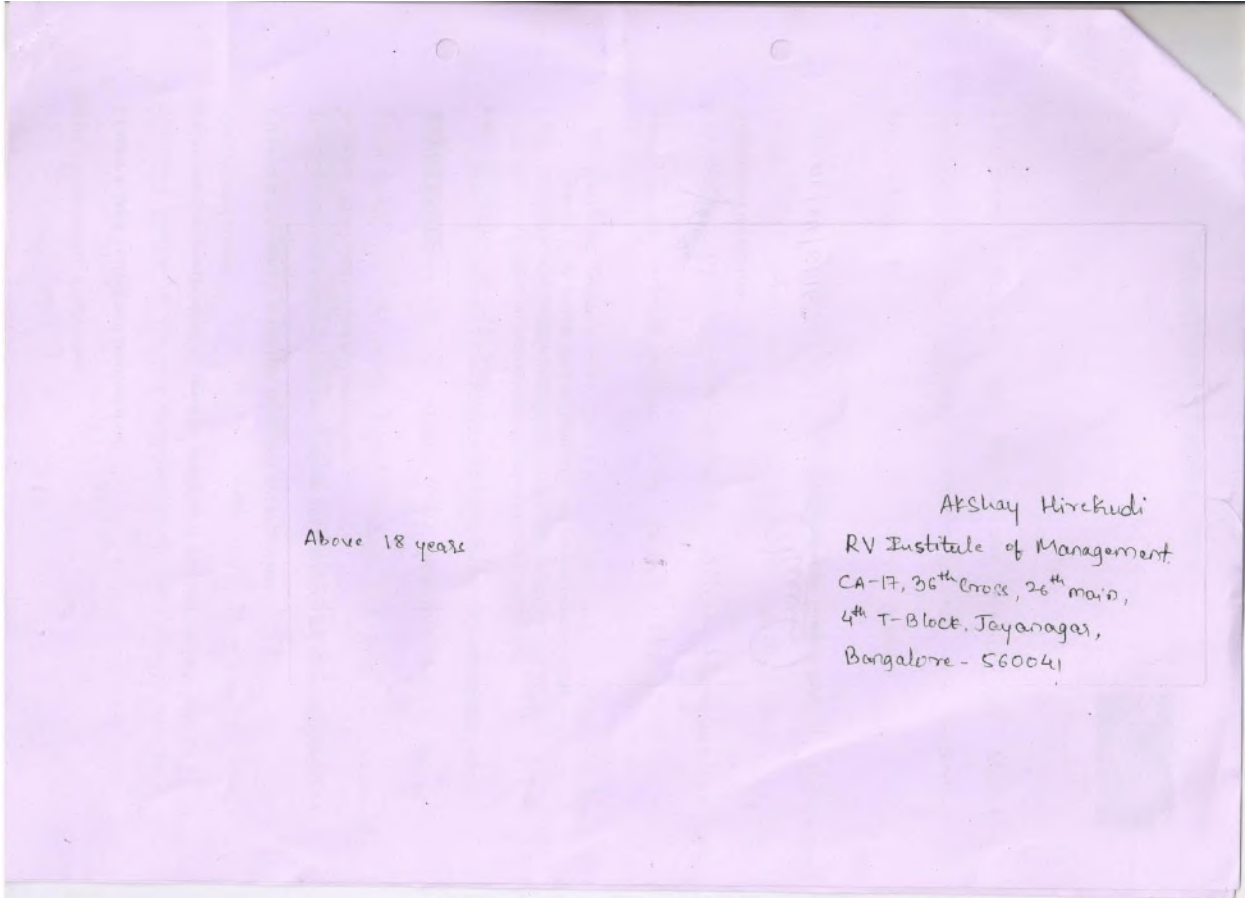
Dear, Bapu Ji.

The way you took all the problems of the country as a challenging and brought freedom to the country from the britishers was very huge achievement for the country man.

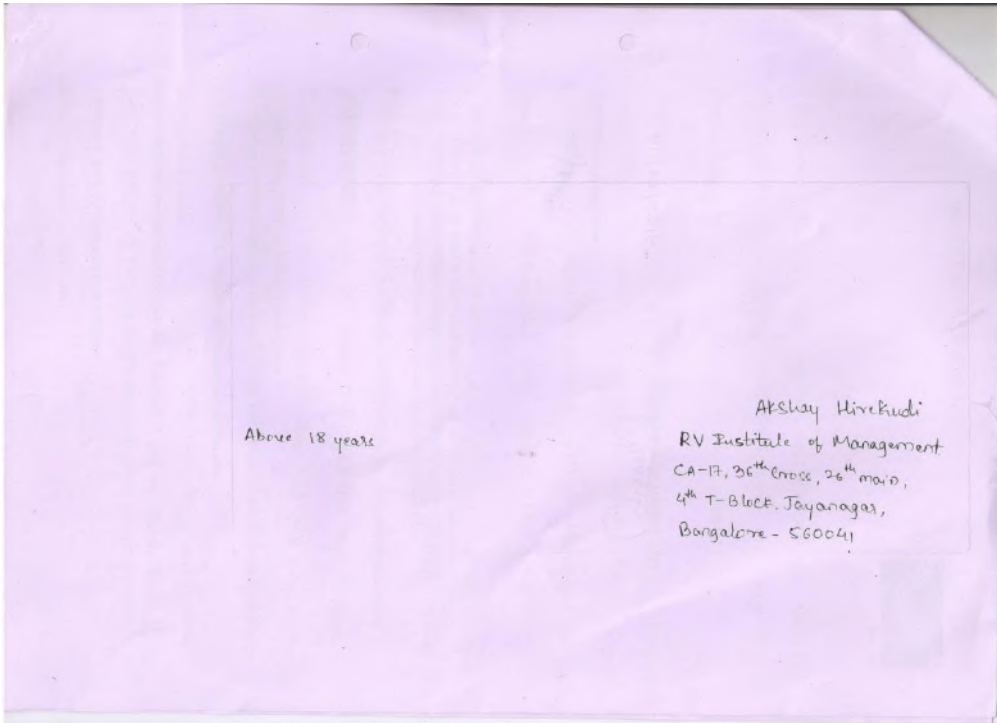
