Student Council

RVIM Student Council is a group of 16 elected students with equal representation from the first and second year, who are pursuing their MBA programme at the Institute. The Council works together with a Chairman (HOI) and Student Welfare Officers and involves in the Institutional decision making process. Student councils play a crucial role in educational institutions by representing the interests and concerns of the student body.

Composition of Student Council:

- 1. **Chairman**: Responsible for appointing the Student Welfare Officers and entrusting the role of running the Council. The chairman also reviews updates about the events from the Student Welfare Officers and the members of the Council.
- 2. **Student Welfare Officers**: There are two faculty members as SWO's responsible for electing the Class representatives, Monitoring and supervising the work of the Class representatives.
- 3. **Elected Student Council Members**: Act as a prime official channel of communication between the Institution and the student community. The council appraises students about all the development happening in the institute.

Roles and Responsibilities of Student Council Members

The members contribute to the overall development of leadership skills, teamwork, and civic engagement among student council members. They are part of Event Planning, Organizing and coordinating Institute events such as dance programmes, fundraising for NGO, and community service projects is often a part of student council responsibilities.
