The subject Innovation Management was a part of curriculum since 2015. The faculty extended the teaching pedagogy by setting up Innovation Lab to inculcate design thinking among students. The lab used the support of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), TED Lessons created by faculty, Flipped Classroom pedagogy and visit to technological museum to inculcate design thinking skills and to generate social innovation ideas. This effort was recognized with AIMS-We School Innovation Award at Faculty level. Today MOOC usage has been extensively utilized in the campus for Innovation Lab exercises. Also all the 160 students are networked with a portal for design and submission of work with provisions for discussions with the use of educational blog for institutions and is available free with institution mail registration

Impact creal of Direct Beneficiarie The garden in the campus is maintained by gardner. Students assisted in maintaining the garden during leisure. The rainwater harvesting was adopted to support water supply. The plastics and water bottles were segregated and sent to recycling centre situated 3 kms from campus. The social innovation lab session were made to develop new ideas implementation in conservation of energy and avoid wastage of water. All such programmes became an excellent work for CSR programmes in the campus. Also important dates were marked for programmes such as June 5- World Environment Day, April 22- World Earth Day and so on. Every special day on the calender had a programme on the day. This model helped students and faculty teams to design CSR programmes. In 2018 RVIM was awarded AIMS -CSR Award for using innovative methods to design programme
