### **Research policy**

The center has taken this policy to increase faculty achievement in research.

- Faculty is encouraged to take up consultancy assignment and the faculty can retain 60% of their revenue and share 40% with the institute.
- Faculty is encouraged to attend FDPs, MDPs, Workshops and conferences organized by reputed institutions and institute will sponsor the same.
- To foster innovative research ideas, research grant in the form of seed money of Rs. 5000 to Rs. 50,000 is offered to internal faculty members to work on their research proposal vetted and approved by the Research Advisory Committee.
- Institute provides cash incentives for publishing research papers in the journals that are indexed in Scopus, WOS, UGC care listed Journals and peer reviewed reputed Journals including FT50.
- Institute also provides cash incentives to the faculty members for sanctioned funded projects to motivate others.
- Institution provides 15 days On Official Duty (OOD) to faculty members for attending and presenting research papers in conferences, symposium, colloquium, seminar etc., organized by institution of repute.
- Institution reimburse the registration fee of conference, seminar etc., organized by reputed institutions attended by faculty members.
- To facilitate increased research output, the institute have subscribe to various research databases (Proquest IQ, EBSCO, J-Gate, etc.) for faculty members to provide online access 24\*7 remotely.
- The institute encourage networking with other institutions (education, research or independent agencies) or universities (national or international) or organizations for

knowledge sharing, exchange programme, training, collaborative research, collaborative extension or collaborative consultancy, immersion etc., through Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

### **Activities of the Centre**

#### For Faculty:

1. Motivating and supporting the faculty members to publish more research papers and to participate and present their papers in the conferences.
2. Conducting workshops for the faculty members to support them in their research work
3. To encourage faculty to identify opportunities for the funded projects and submit proposals for the same.
4. To encourage and support faculty to complete their minor and major projects on time.
5. To encourage and support faculty to write at least two case studies in a year.

#### For Research Scholars:

1. Meeting with research scholars will be held continuously on monthly basis on every second Saturday.
2. Guiding the scholars in their research work as per their requirement
3. Collecting progress report from the scholars on monthly basis and submitting the consolidated report to the director.
4. Conducting workshops for the scholars to support them in their research work.
5. Creating and maintaining database of research scholars (internal and external) associated with RVIMRC
6. Motivating and supporting scholars to publish more research papers and to participate and present their papers in the conferences.

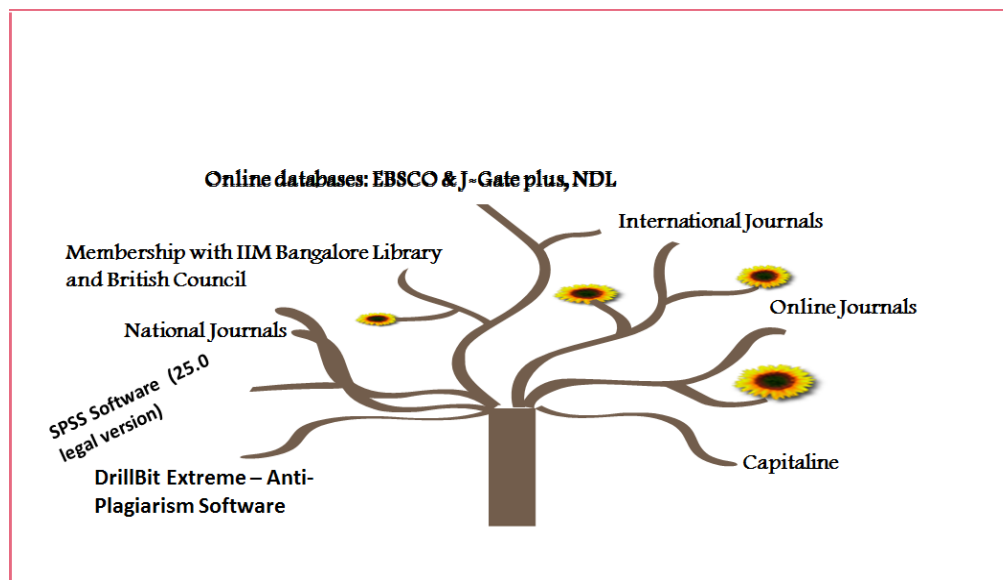
#### For Students
