
Academic Papers: Crafting A Manuscript

- · Methodology


WHERE DOES A PROBLEM STATEMENT ORIGINATE FROM?

- · A good problem originates from a research question formulated out of observation of the reality.
- · A literature review and a study of previous experiments, and research, are good sources of research questions that are converted to statements of problem.
- · Many scientific researchers look at an area where a previous researcher generated some interesting results, but never followed up. It could be an interesting area of research, which nobody else has

- Most scholars develop identity along one axis

 - A theoretical perspective and a phenomenon








Dr. Souvik Dutta is an Assistant Professor in Economics at Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology Delhi (IIITD) since December 2019. He specializes in the fields of Development Economics, Game Theory and Digital Economy. Before joining IIITD, he was a faculty at Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) where he received the

Young Faculty Research Chair (2015-18).

Some of the major projects include studying microfinance and informal insurance for microfinance, which was funded by International Growth Center, London School of Economics. Other projects involve evaluating the World Bank funded, Institutional Strengthening of Gram Panchayats (ISGP) project for panchayats in West Bengal which is sponsored by IIM Bangalore. He is presently working on studying the effectiveness of decentralization of irrigation systems in the context of "pani panchayats" in Orissa funded jointly by Monash University, Australia and Environment for Development (EfD), University of Gothenburg, Sweden. He is recently working on a project to design a mechanism to reduce fake followers in influencer marketing and also the impact of clickbait on the shareability of an article. His research involves primary surveys, secondary data and technical methods like propensity score matching, regression discontinuity designs and difference-in-difference methods.

Dr. Dutta holds a Ph.D in Economics from Pennsylvania State University, USA, Masters in Economics from Delhi School of Economics and an undergraduate degree in Economics from Presidency College, Kolkata.



Dr. M H Bala Subrahmanya is a Professor of Economics at the Department of Management Studies, Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore. He has more than 30 years of professional experience, of which more than 24 years are in IISc. During his professional career he received Commonwealth Fellowship (1999-2000); Japan Foundation Fellowship (2004/2005); and Fulbright-Nehru Senior Research Fellowship (2009/2010). He has worked as a Visiting Research Fellow at University of Durham, UK (February-July 2000); National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS) Tokyo, Japan (March 2005 - February 2006); and at University of California, Davis, USA (September 2009 – April 2010). He has more than 100 publications to his credit comprising research papers in refereed national and international journals, International Conferences, books and monographs. 
Dr. Charan Singh

Dr. Charan Singh is currently serving as the Non Executive Chairman of Punjab & Sind Bank. He was full time visiting faculty and former RBI Chair Professor (Dec 2012 to Dec 2016) at the Indian Institute of Management Bangalore, India where he taught comparative monetary policy and policy issues in Indian economy.

Earlier, he was a Senior Economist at the Independent Evaluation Office of the International Monetary Fund, Washington DC from August 2009 to November 2012 and Research Director (Departments: Economic Policy, Debt Management) at the Reserve Bank of India (1997–2009). Singh earned his doctorate in Economics from the University of New South Wales, Sydney, Australia. He was a visiting scholar for more than a year each at Department of Economics, Harvard University and the Stanford Center for International Development, Stanford University. He is now serving as Director on the Board of National Housing Bank, Delhi and NABARD Financial Services Ltd, Bangalore. He is also Member, Governing Board at Policy Foundation, New Delhi; Member of Research Advisory Committee, BIRD, National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development; Honorary Fellow, SKOCH Development Foundation; and Member of the Informal Advisory Group on Housing Sector Issues, IMF, Washington DC.



Dr. Pawan Kumar Singh




PROFILE OF PROF. AZHAR KAZMI

Prof. Azhar Kazmi graduated in mechanical engineering from Birla Institute of Technology & Science, Pilani after his schooling from St. Anselm's School, Ajmer. He is an MBA from Podar Institute of Management, Jaipur. He was awarded Ph.D. degree in Management by the Kurukshetra University. Besides academic degrees, Prof. Kazmi has also received professional diplomas in Training & Development and in Distance Education.

After gaining industrial experience in engineering and management, Prof. Kazmi joined the academia and has served Kurukshetra University and Ajmer University where he was the founder - Director of the School of Management & Information Studies and Dean, Faculty of Management Studies. He worked at Aligarh Muslim University earlier as Dean, Faculty of Commerce and as Professor& Chairman, Department of Business Administration and the Dean, Faculty of Management Studies & Research. After completing a five-year professorial assignment at the International Islamic University Malaysia at Kuala Lumpur he is now teaching as a Visiting Professor in Management at the King Fahd University of Petroleum & Minerals at Dhahran, Saudi Arabia.


Prof. Kazmi has got several publications to his credit including books, research articles and papers. His book Strategic Management published by McGraw-Hill had been adjudged the Best Indian Management Book for the year 1994. He has been awarded the Ishan Award as the Best Author in Management for 1997. The fifth edition of the book is in press. Another book Business Responsibility by Cengage was published in 2018. His paper in the Indian Journal of Training and Development won the Best Paper Award for 2000. His research contributions have been acknowledged by several leading journals in India and abroad. Besides teaching, where he is considered to be a popular teacher much loved and respected by his students, Prof. Kazmi has extensive experience of organizing training programmes and managing consultancy projects and is an administrator of proven excellence. A Salzburg Fellow from Austria, Prof. Kazmi is a member of several professional bodies in India and abroad. He was the Vice Chairman of the Strategic Management Forum of India (1997 - 98), a member of the National Council of Indian Society for Training and Development (1998 - 99), a member of the Executive Board of the Association of Indian Management Schools, and a member on the Diploma Programme Committee of the Indian Society for Training and Development.

Prof. Kazmi's current interests are in the area of strategic management in developing economies, applications of sustainability to strategic planning in organizations, and business responsibility.
