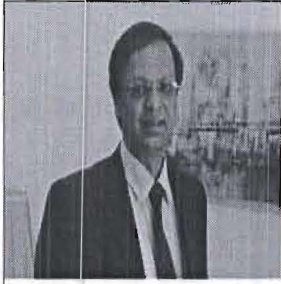

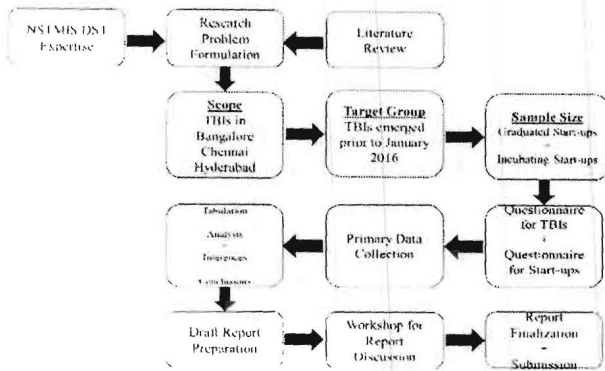
Academic Papers: Crafting A Manuscript

- Six Major Components
- Introduction and Motivation
 - The problem should have broad practical and academic relevance.
 - Should be generalizable.
- Literature Review
 - It is not copy paste job.
 - Relevant vs. Irrelevant literature.
- Hypothesis Development
 - Intuitive vs. Non-intuitive hypothesis.
 - Literature is not hypothesis.
- Methodology

WHERE DOES A PROBLEM STATEMENT ORIGINATE FROM?

- A good problem originates from a research question formulated out of observation of the reality.
- A literature review and a study of previous experiments, and research, are good sources of research questions that are converted to statements of problem.
- Many scientific researchers look at an area where a previous researcher generated some interesting results, but never followed up. It could be an interesting area of research, which nobody else has fully explored.

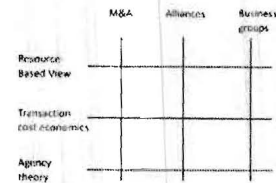
RESEARCH PROCESS

Brief Description

Mr. Sourav Borah is a doctoral candidate in Marketing at IIM Bangalore. His research interest includes Services Marketing, Branding and Ethical issues in Management. He has published papers in many international journals including Indian Journal of Marketing, European Journal of Business Management. He has also presented papers in many international conferences. He has received best paper award in International Conference on Brand Management, IMT Ghaziabad, 2010 and 7th SIMSR Asia Marketing Conference, K. J. Somaiya Institute of Management Studies & Research, Mumbai, 2012. He has also been awarded with "*Best research scholar award, ITM Business School*", Navi Mumbai, 2008-10. Prior to IIM Bangalore, he was associated with Indian School of Business, Hyderabad where he served as a Senior Academic Associate. He has completed his Engineering from Jorhat Engineering College, Assam and PGDM from ITM Business School, Navi Mumbai.



Dr. Souvik Dutta is an Assistant Professor in Economics at Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology Delhi (IIITD) since December 2019. He specializes in the fields of Development Economics, Game Theory and Digital Economy. Before joining IIITD, he was a faculty at Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) where he received the Young Faculty Research Chair (2015-18).

Some of the major projects include studying microfinance and informal insurance for microfinance, which was funded by International Growth Center, London School of Economics. Other projects involve evaluating the World Bank funded, Institutional Strengthening of Gram Panchayats (ISGP) project for panchayats in West Bengal which is sponsored by IIM Bangalore. He is presently working on studying the effectiveness of decentralization of irrigation systems in the context of “pani panchayats” in Orissa funded jointly by Monash University, Australia and Environment for Development (Efd), University of Gothenburg, Sweden. He is recently working on a project to design a mechanism to reduce fake followers in influencer marketing and also the impact of clickbait on the shareability of an article. His research involves primary surveys, secondary data and technical methods like propensity score matching, regression discontinuity designs and difference-in-difference methods.

Dr. Dutta holds a Ph.D in Economics from Pennsylvania State University, USA, Masters in Economics from Delhi School of Economics and an undergraduate degree in Economics from Presidency College, Kolkata.

Dr. M H Bala Subrahmanya is a Professor of Economics at the Department of Management Studies, Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore. He has more than 30 years of professional experience, of which more than 24 years are in IISc. During his professional career he received Commonwealth Fellowship (1999-2000); Japan Foundation Fellowship (2004/2005); and Fulbright-Nehru Senior Research Fellowship (2009/2010). He has worked as a Visiting Research Fellow at University of Durham, UK (February-July 2000); National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS) Tokyo, Japan (March 2005 - February 2006); and at University of California, Davis, USA (September 2009 – April 2010). He has more than 100 publications to his credit comprising research papers in refereed national and international journals, International Conferences, books and monographs. He is on the Editorial Advisory Board of (i) International Journal of Entrepreneurial Behaviour & Research, UK; *Aarthica Charche*: The FPI Journal of Economics and Governance, Fiscal Policy Institute, Government of Karnataka, Bangalore; International Journal of Global Business and Competitiveness; Amity Journal of Economics, New Delhi; Associate Editor of Asian Journal of Innovation and Policy, and Current Science Journal, among others. His field of specialization is Industrial Economics.

Dr. Charan Singh is currently serving as the Non Executive Chairman of Punjab & Sind Bank. He was full time visiting faculty and former RBI Chair Professor (Dec 2012 to Dec 2016) at the Indian Institute of Management Bangalore, India where he taught comparative monetary policy and policy issues in Indian economy.

Earlier, he was a Senior Economist at the Independent Evaluation Office of the International Monetary Fund, Washington DC from August 2009 to November 2012 and Research Director (Departments: Economic Policy, Debt Management) at the Reserve Bank of India (1997–2009). Singh earned his doctorate in Economics from the University of New South Wales, Sydney, Australia. He was a visiting scholar for more than a year each at Department of Economics, Harvard University and the Stanford Center for International Development, Stanford University. He is now serving as Director on the Board of National Housing Bank, Delhi and NABARD Financial Services Ltd, Bangalore. He is also Member, Governing Board at Policy Foundation, New Delhi; Member of Research Advisory Committee, BIRD, National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development; Honorary Fellow, SKOCH Development Foundation; and Member of the Informal Advisory Group on Housing Sector Issues, IMF, Washington DC.

Dr. Pawan Kumar Singh is at present working as Director of Management Development Institute Gurgaon. Previously he has worked as Director In-charge of Indian Institute of Management Indore and Chair Academic Committee of Indian Institute of Management Sambalpur. As Nodal Officer of IIM Sambalpur, he played a sheet anchor role in establishing the new institute in its initial phase.

Dr. Singh has been in academics at post-graduate level for more than three decades. He has worked as Professor of Organisational Behaviour and Human Resource Management at IIM Indore. Before that, he worked with National Institute of Industrial Engineering Mumbai, Indira Gandhi National Open University New Delhi, Kanpur University, and Vikram University at Ujjain. He started his career at Bank of India as Industrial Relations Officer.

Dr. Singh has long experience in teaching, training, research, consulting, and academic administration. He has published research articles in national and international journals and has presented papers in various conferences in India and abroad. He has written two books in the field of Management. He has trained more than 15,000 executives of all levels from almost all walks of profession. He has provided consultancy to public and private sector organisations.
