RV Institute of Management recently hosted an enlightening talk by Ms. Yashi Dhariwal on the topic "Cambodia and Beyond" where the speaker highlighted the Job Opportunities, Geo-Political Culture, Student and Faculty Exchange in Cambodia. The event, attended by students of RVIM provided a comprehensive overview of Cambodia's evolving landscape and the opportunities it presents.

The Event was also graced by Mr. S. Jayaraam, DGM, Business Standard; Dr. Pururshottam Bung, Professor and Director, RVIM. And Mr. Madhu Chikkaiah, Group Officer, Business Standard.

Ms. Yashi Dhariwal is an Author and the Head of the Political and Economic Department at the Honorary Consulate of Cambodia in Bangalore. She has a background in Political Science and International Relations. Her book, 'International Relations for Civil Service Aspirants' has guided the UPSC aspirants in their preparation journey. She has previously worked in the Political Department of the Chinese Consulate at Kolkata

Ms. Dhariwal, began her talk by highlighting the burgeoning job market in Cambodia. She pointed out that the country is experiencing rapid economic growth, driven by sectors such as manufacturing, tourism, and agriculture. The Cambodian government's focus on attracting foreign investment has led to a surge in job opportunities, especially for skilled professionals in finance, technology, and education.

In her discussion on Cambodia's geo-political culture, Ms. Dhariwal emphasized the country's strategic location in Southeast Asia and its role in regional politics. She noted that Cambodia's relationships with its neighbours, particularly Vietnam, Thailand, and China, are crucial in shaping its political and economic policies. The speaker also touched upon the historical context, explaining how past conflicts and current political dynamics influence Cambodia's development trajectory.

A significant portion of the talk was dedicated to the opportunities for student and faculty exchange programs between India and Cambodia. Ms. Dhariwal encouraged institutions to foster partnerships that would allow for academic collaboration and cultural exchange. She highlighted the mutual benefits of such programs, including enhanced learning experiences, research opportunities, and the strengthening of bilateral ties.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A segment, where attendees had the opportunity to delve deeper into specific aspects of the talk. Questions ranged from the practicalities of finding jobs





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in Cambodia to the logistics of setting up exchange programs. Ms. Dhariwal provided detailed responses, further enriching the audience's understanding of Cambodia's potential.

The event at RV Institute of Management was co-ordinated by Faculty co-ordinator, Ms. Pooja Takalkar and it inspired the attendees about the prospects in Cambodia.
