



Dear Principal/Director,

The Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India is implementing a Special Scholarship Scheme for J&K (SSS J&K) from the year 2011 for the students belonging to J&K who, after passing Class XII or equivalent examination from J&K secure admission in institutions located outside the State of J&K. An Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC), of MHRD on Special Scholarship Scheme , chaired by Secretary (Higher Education), in its 2nd meeting held on 23rd August, 2012, decided to create Two supernumerary seats across all the institutes/colleges for this purpose.

Accordingly, UGC vide D.O. No:F.1-1/2012(SA-III) dated:01.10.2012 and AICTE vide Letter No. F.5-84/2012/AICTE/J&K(Seats)/1016 dated:08.11.2012 respectively issued instructions for creation of Two (02) Supernumerary Seats in institutions under Section 2(f) and 12(b) and AICTE approved institutions respectively.

For the Academic Year 2014-15, IMC in its 10th meeting held on 17th April, 2014 approved the procedure of admissions for TWO (02) supernumerary seats based on counseling. Accordingly, AICTE is conducting Counseling from 30.08.2014 to 05.09.2014 at S P College Srinagar.

Further, The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its order date 29.08.2014 passed in IA No, 53 in civil appeal No 9048 of 2012 has extended the cutoff date for admission of J&K students under the aforesaid Special Scholarship Scheme (SSS) of MHRD, Government of India, for academic session 2014-15 up to 5th September 2014.

All the Institution to which such students are allotted seats through the Centralized Counseling, are hereby informed that:

- 1. The Student admitted is directed to report within ONE WEEK from the date as listed in the Provisional Offer Letter issued to the student.
- 2. All the original documents should be verified by the institute.
- 3. The tuition fee, hostel fee and other incidental charges of students admitted under the scheme will be reimbursed by MHRD, Government of India, through

AICTE (within the limit mentioned in the "Guidelines for Special Scholarship Scheme 2014 - 2015") available at http://aicte-jk-scholarship.in >Academic

Year>2014-15, and the same may not be collected from the students.

4. The Institute shall submit claims for tuition fee, hostel fee and other incidental charges to AICTE in prescribed Performa available at





# Institutes of higher education to get intake incentives

BENGALURU, DHNS: The Higher Education department (HED) has come up with an initiative to provide seat intake incentives to aided and unaided colleges demonstrating high performance, from the academic year 2015-16.

As per a recent Government Order, the department has given such institutions the advantage of increasing their intake without having to go through the conventional permission procedure. Institutions that have secured the NAAC A and A+ grades with valid scores, would be qualified. To avail of the benefit, the colleges would have to assure the government of giving 25 percent of the increased intake seats to students from economically weaker sections of society. They would also have to ensure quality infrastructure and standards of teaching and non-teaching staff.

The institutions have to submit a proposal to the Principal Secretary, HED, before December 31, with regard to the number of seats they wish to add. The colleges will have the freedom to chose the courses for which they wish to increase the intake. They will also have to provide details about the existing course-wise and programme-wise intake. The colleges will be permitted to increase their intake without mandatory inspection. The department will communicate the increase in intake within 15 days failing which it will be deemed that the colleges had been granted the permission.

Further, once the proposal is accepted, the acceptance letter will directly be forwarded to the university concerned. However, the universities will have the liberty to send Local Inquiry Committees (LIC) for inspection of the colleges, according to the press statement from Sandhya L Nayak, Undersecretary of LIFD.

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
