- Third Session conducted by Dr.Purushottam Bung, on the topic develop and deliver, it was a mix
 of activity and learning. This session began with the picking of solution and beginning to
 prototype the solution proposed.
- Fourth session was conducted by Abhijith Bhat, who gave a concluding process remark. This session was building the ability of identifying a saleable idea making it a winning solution. So this session brought out the importance of feedback on the thought out prototype.

 Major learning's at the session will be that Design Thinking concepts and it as a way of thinking will be more familiar and relevant.
