1. Overview

RV Institute of Management successfully organised a Three-Day Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on ODOO ERP from 22nd to 24th September 2024, in collaboration with ODOO LLP. The programme was designed to equip faculty members from RVIM and partner institutions with practical knowledge and hands-on exposure to ODOO's Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) platform, enabling them to integrate industry-relevant digital tools into management education.

The FDP successfully brought together faculty participants from multiple institutions, bridging the academic–industry gap and strengthening institutional collaborations. It contributed to capacity building in technology-enabled management education, with special focus on Supply Chain Management and E-Commerce applications.

2. Objectives of the Programme

- Provide faculty with in-depth, hands-on exposure to ODOO ERP and its business modules.
- Bridge the gap between academic curriculum and industry-level ERP implementation practices.
- Enable design and delivery of an ODOO-integrated university programme for MBA students.
- Strengthen external academic–industry connect with ODOO LLP.
- Enhance institutional visibility and establish RVIM as a leader in technology-enabled management education.
- Prepare foundation for inducing ODOO ERP into the Supply Chain Management – E-Commerce subject from the next academic year.



3. Programme Schedule

Day 1	22 Sep 2024	Introduction to ODOO ERP; Overview of ERP architecture; Navigation and interface familiarisation; ODOO modules walkthrough (Sales, Purchase, Inventory, Accounting); Hands-on setup and database configuration.
Day 2	23 Sep 2024	Deep dive into Supply Chain Management module; E-Commerce integration in ODOO; Digital process automation; Inventory and warehouse management; Live demonstrations and faculty-led exercises.
Day 3	24 Sep 2024	Advanced ODOO configurations; Academic integration planning; Design of ODOO University Programme for MBA; Certificate distribution and valedictory session.

4. Key Outcomes and Achievements

- Faculty participants gained comprehensive hands-on experience with ODOO ERP across multiple functional modules.
- Strengthened academic–industry partnership between RVIM and ODOO LLP.
- Enhanced institutional visibility by positioning RVIM as a pioneer in ERP-integrated management education.
- Capacity building achieved across faculty from multiple participating institutions.
- University ODOO Programme for MBA successfully designed and finalised during the FDP.
- ODOO ERP to be formally inducted into the Supply Chain Management – E-Commerce subject curriculum from the next academic year.

5. University ODOO Programme for MBA

A landmark outcome of this FDP was the creation of a structured University ODOO Programme tailored for MBA students at RVIM. The programme curriculum was co-developed with inputs from ODOO LLP and will be integrated as a component of the Supply Chain Management – E-Commerce subject. This initiative ensures that MBA students receive industry-aligned, practical ERP training as part of their formal academic programme.
