Institutional Research Funding Research Proposals for 2023 (February)

Introduction

The Centre for Research & Consultancy at RVIM provides institutional research funding to support research initiatives. For cutting-edge research in management and social science subjects with implications for theory, concepts, methodology, social change, and policy, the institution offer funds to the internal faculty members. The Centre for Research & Consultancy at RVIM shall award the research projects on the basis of the scope, duration of the study and budget up to Rs. 50,000 for the duration of 6 months.

Application Process



The call for the research proposal was announced on 14th February 2023 and one month time was given to all the faculty members to conceptualize the research proposal and submit it to the Centre for Research & Consultancy through a google form.

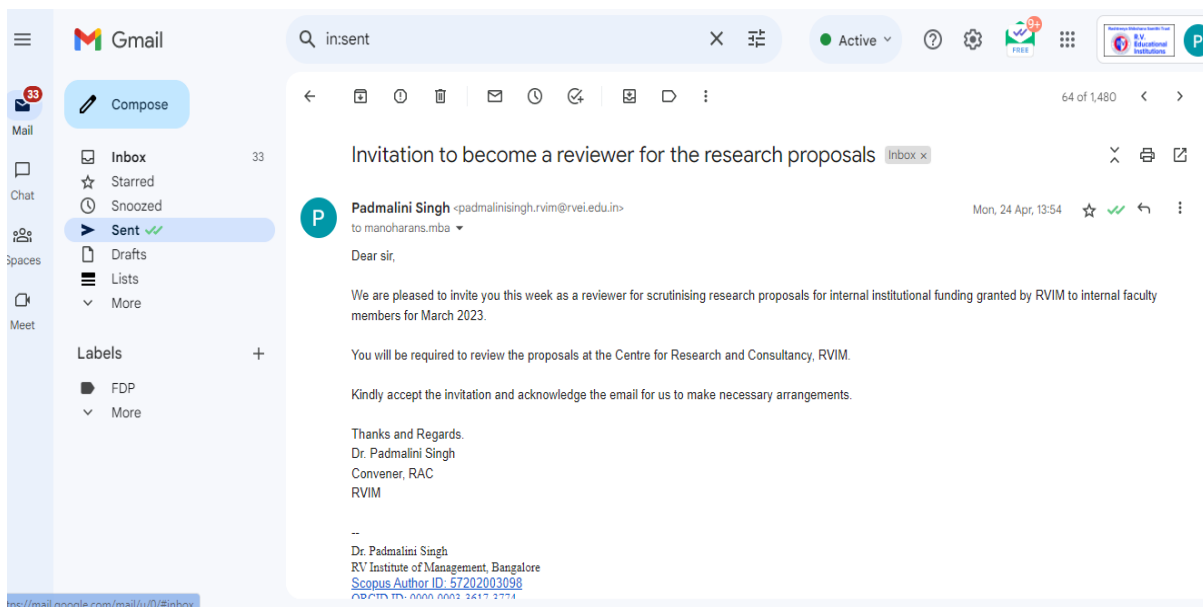

After receiving the proposals, the Centre for Research & Consultancy to review seven research proposals submitted by internal faculty members invited two external reviewers for the double blind review process. These reviewers are part of Research Advisory Committee – Dr. Ujjal Mukherjee, Jain University and Dr. Elangovan N, Christ University. The standard review format was provided to both the reviewers. The review process was completed in the institutions separately by both the reviewers on 28th March and 30th March 2023 respectively. The reviewers gave detailed feedback and suggestions on each research proposal.

The feedback and suggestions were shared with each applicant to incorporate the suggestions and resubmit the proposals for the third blind review. The applicants were given one week time for the resubmission.



Upon resubmission, third reviewer was invited for final blind review. The same format was provided to the third reviewer as well to maintain uniformity. The final blind review was completed by Dr. Manohar, Professor & HOD, B.M.S. College of Engineering, Bangalore on 26th April 2023.



After the completion of the triple blind review process, the applicants were intimated for a presentation and discussion on 12th May 2023. All the participants were present and round of discussions went on over all the research proposals.

The approval was taken by the Management for releasing the Sanction Orders to the selected research proposals. The details are:
