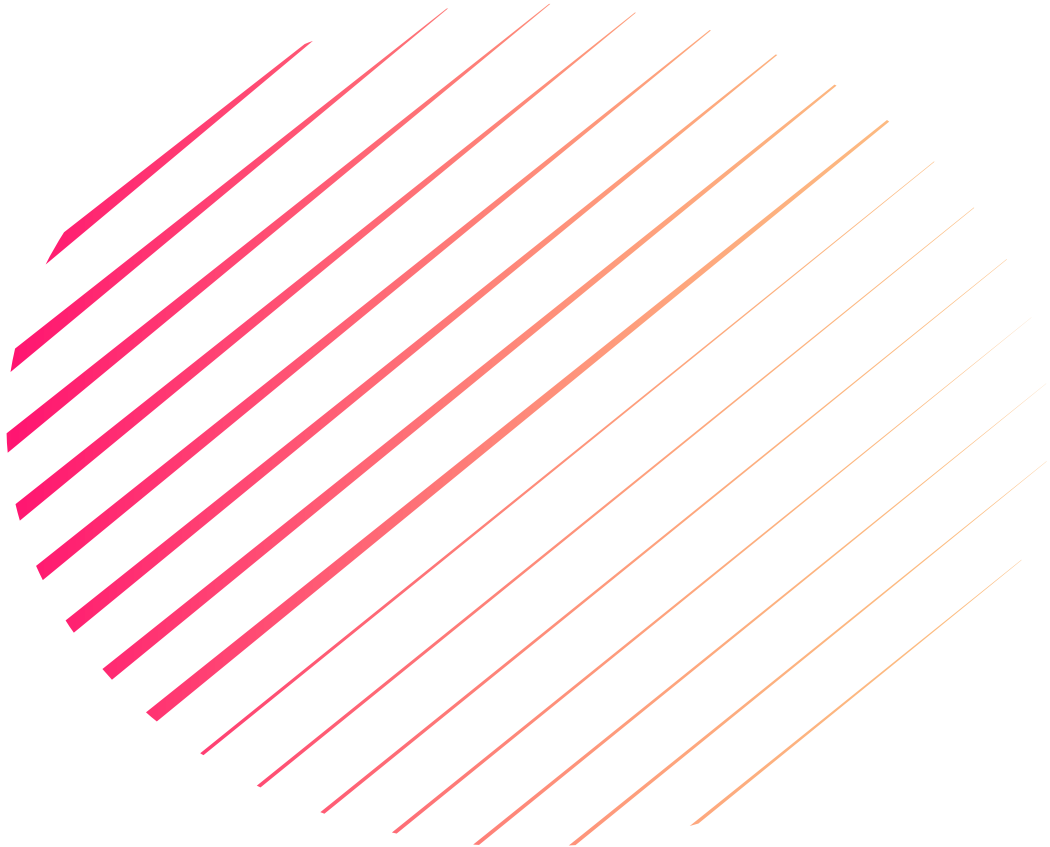


Networking through UBA Villages Alapnahalli and Attibele in Hosakote for Identifying Contact Points for Medical Teleconsultation

RVIM has initiated Medical Teleconsultation services through support of Medical Team in its Unnat Bharat Abhiyan adopted Villages

RVIM Student volunteers worked together to identify contact points for identifying communication channels to reach health awareness programmes on Day 3 of lockdown in Karnataka.

They also identified schools and NGOs working for welfare of Visually Challenged to initiate support and awareness programmes and also to identify learning support needs during lockdown.

A Online Google Map search was conducted in Alapannahalli surrounding to identify Essential Services and Other Offices so as to share the teleconsultation facilities.

Attibele Provision Shop

The provision shop is in front of the Government School in Attibele. Anusha has communicated to the shop to provide volunteering service to communicate to the residents regarding availing of teleconsultation services . Many farmers and residents visit this shop as it is situated near Bus Stop. The shopkeeper can help in displaying the Phone Numbers at the shop and reach through their contacts. All such initiatives are voluntary service and with the complete observance of preventive measures .

The poster image with phone numbers shall be circulated to all the communication points identified using google maps from Alapannahalli and surrounding villages upto Hoskote.

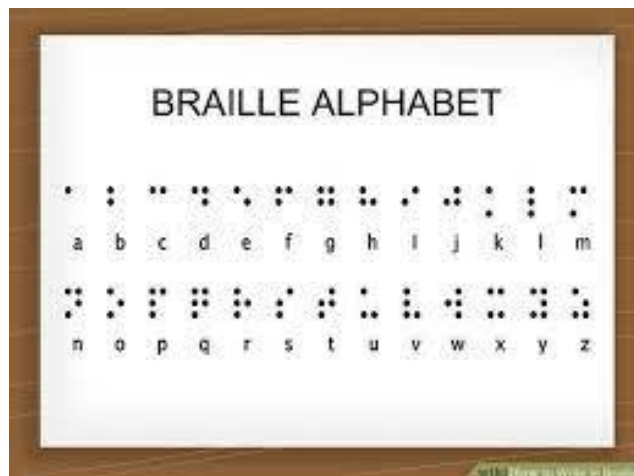
Helping Hand to Visually Challenged

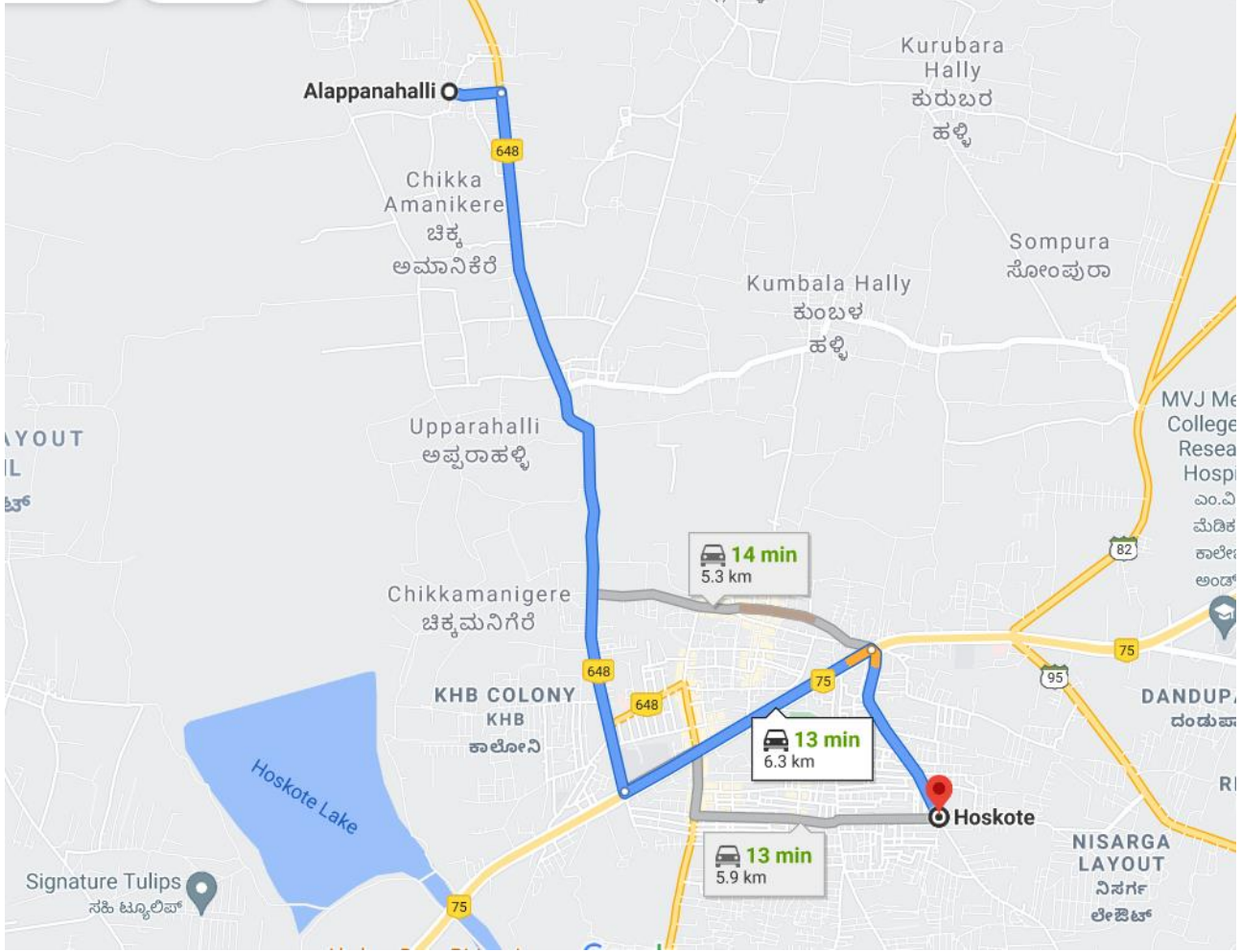
