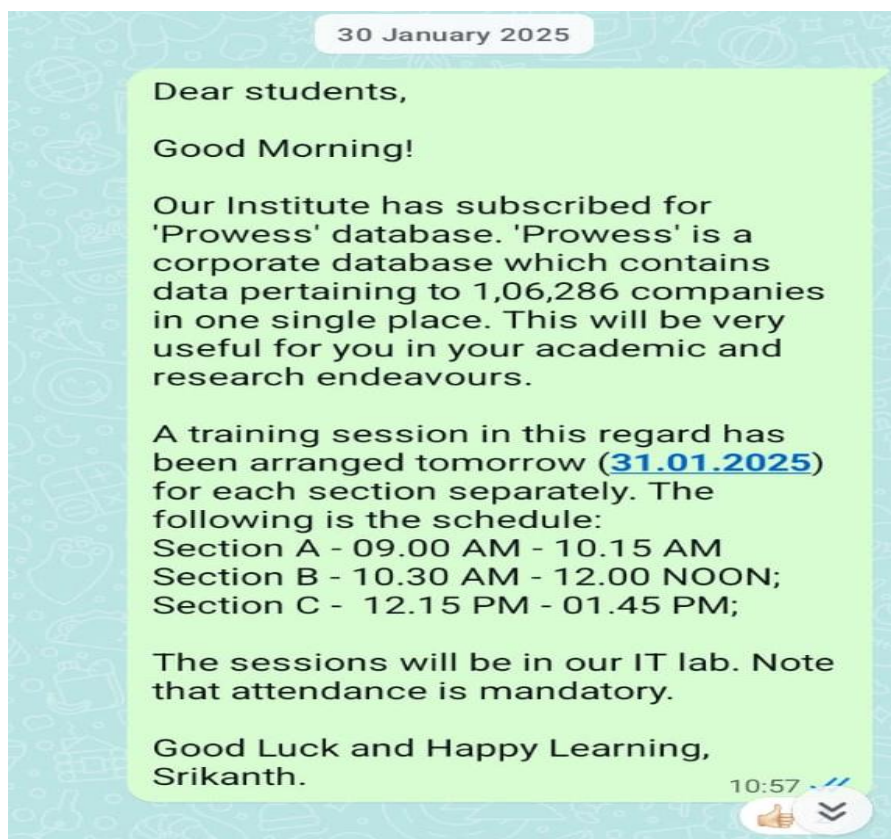

1. EVENT OVERVIEW

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT

The workshop was organized with the following key objectives:

1. To introduce students to the CMIE ProwessIQ database, a premier source for financial performance data of Indian companies.
2. To provide hands-on training on extracting fundamental financial data, share prices, and annual report highlights.
3. To facilitate data-driven research capabilities for students' assignments, summer internships, and final year projects.
4. To bridge the gap between financial theory and empirical data analysis through industry-standard tools.

3. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A series of workshop-style training sessions on the Prowess database were conducted to empower students with financial research skills. Recognizing the different academic requirements of the batches, the training was customized for both Junior and Senior students. The sessions for the Juniors (Sections A, B, and C) focused on foundational data navigation, while the session for the Seniors (Sections A, B, and C) emphasized advanced data extraction for research purposes.

Held in the IT Lab, the sessions provided every student with terminal access to interact with the database in real-time. Mr. Debrishi from CMIE served as the expert resource person, ensuring that students understood the nuances of company financial structures and sectoral data available on the platform.

4. PARTICIPANT PROFILE & ENROLLMENT

The workshop saw high levels of engagement across the management batches. The participation was recorded as follows:

- **Juniors (1st Year):** * Section A: 59 Students
 - Section B: 60 Students
 - Section C: 60 Students
- **Seniors (2nd Year):** * Consolidated Sections A, B & C: 98 Students

Total Attendance: 277 Students

This inclusive approach ensured that the first-year students developed an early interest in financial research, while the senior students received the technical support necessary for their specialized finance electives and corporate research tasks.

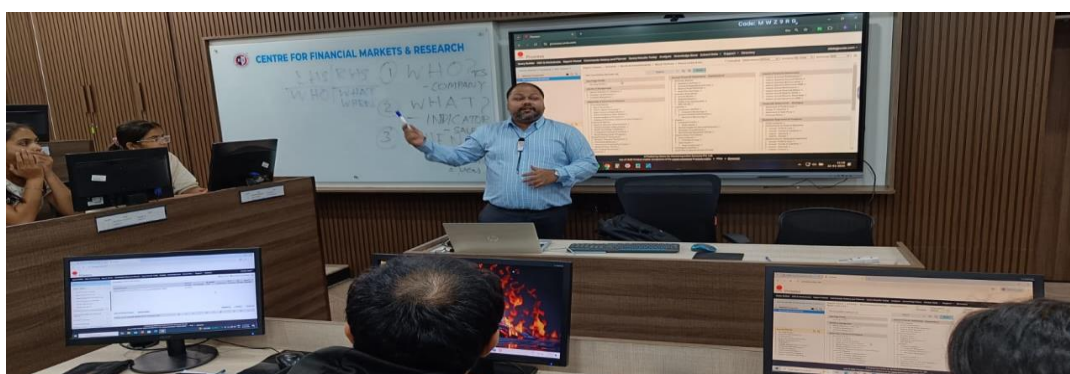
5. RESOURCE PERSON PROFILE

6. HIGHLIGHTS & OUTCOMES

- **Hands-on Navigation:** Students learned to create query sets based on financial parameters such as PBDIT, Debt-Equity ratios, and Net Profit margins.
- **Research Readiness:** The training specifically addressed the needs of senior students currently working on their specialized projects, teaching them how to export bulk data into Excel for analysis.
- **Real-time Queries:** Mr. Debrishi demonstrated the live extraction of corporate governance data and ownership patterns, encouraging students to ask critical questions about company performance.
- **Institutional Skill Enhancement:** By mastering Prowess, students have acquired a skill highly valued by financial consulting firms, investment banks, and KPOs.

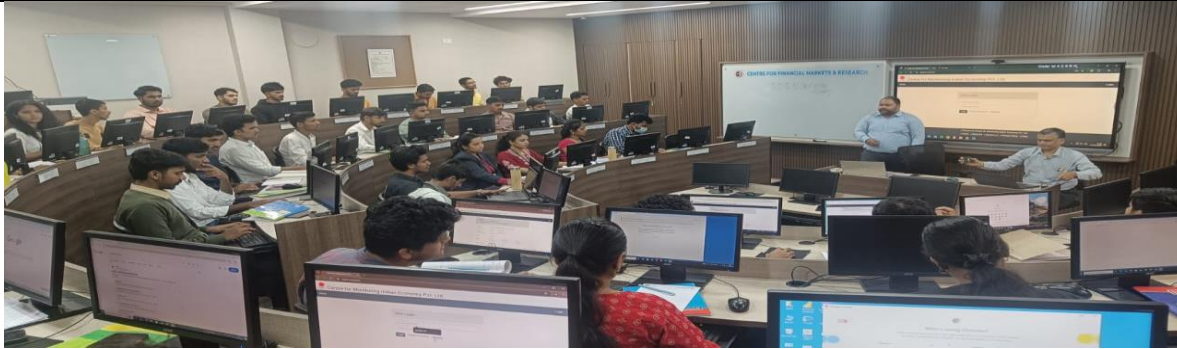
