- Following ICMR guidelines (2017) for biomedical and health research, Guidance Document on Good Academic Research Practices by the UGC (August 2020), UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) UGC Regulations 2018, and the best practices followed by reputed institutions, RVIM has constituted a Research Ethics Review Board (RERB).

 - . Member Secretary Convener of the Research Centre (1)
 - Members Any Two Senior faculty members as nominated by the Director (2) and three external members (3)
- The tenure of the members of RERB shall be for three years (2023-2026).

Agenda point 4: To discuss and approve the Research Ethics Policy of RVIM

OBSERVATIONS

- RERB members advised to create an Application form for Ethics Clearance before carrying out any research.
- A consent form is required to be signed by any researcher before starting the data collection.
- The guidelines for Patents should also be included in the Research Ethics Policy.
- The Quorum should be mentioned in Grievance Redressal Mechanism.

DISCUSSION

- The RERB members discussed that an Application form must be created for the researchers that shall capture the research details and submitted to RERB for Ethics clearance, whenever required.
- It was also advised to create a Consent form that should be submitted by the researcher to inform that they have received the consent from the respondents before gathering the responses for their research, whenever required.
- RERB members suggested to add the guidelines for Patents in the Research Ethics Policy to make it clear whether the researcher's Patent will be in the institution's name, author's name or company's name (if it is sponsored by the company) or will be held collectively.
- The members suggested to add Quorum of minimum five members with atleast 1 external member for Grievance Redressal if any.

RESOLUTION

- The Application form for Ethics Clearance as advised by RERB members will be created under the guidance of RV University.
- The Consent form for data collection will be prepared under the guidance of RV University.
- The guidelines for Patents will be added in the Research Ethics Policy as advised by the RERB member.
- The Quorum of minimum five members with atleast 1 external member for Grievance Redressal Mechanism will be added in the Research Ethics Policy.

Agenda point 5: Any other matters with the permission of the chair

As there were no other matter to be discussed, the meeting was concluded with appreciating and congratulating RVIM for taking good initiatives aimed at fostering ethical research. The meeting ended with discussing the collaboration possibilities of internship, research and consultancy with students and faculty of both the institutions RV University and RV Institute of Legal Studies.
