

Annexure-4 Profile of the Chief Guest Air Marshall H.B Rajaram

Air Marshal HB Rajaram PVSM AVSM VSM was commissioned in the Administrative Branch of the IAF in Jun 1977. The Air Marshal is a post graduate in science from University of Mysore and an alumnus of College of Defence Management (CDM) and Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA). He has held various appointments which include Senior Air Traffic Control Officer (SATCO) and Chief GCA Controller at Fighter bases, Instructional tenure at Air Force Academy, Chief Admin Officer of a fighter base, Chief Personal Staff Officer of an operational Command; Interviewing Officer at Air Force Selection Board where selection of candidates for officer's post is held; a tenure at Directorate of Air Staff Inspection which conducts inspection of Air Force units for operational efficiency and Air Officer Commanding at 23 Equipment Depot. He has been a Cat 'AYE' Air Traffic Controller which is the highest category for a controller and been an Air Force Examiner in Air Traffic Control. Before taking over as Air Officer in charge Administration (AOA) Air Marshal HB Rajaram was holding the portfolio of Director General (Works and Ceremonial). He also held the important portfolio of Assistant Chief of Air Staff (Air Force Works) for about one & amp; half year and was responsible for overseeing the total infrastructure requirement of Indian Air Force. As AOA he was responsible for administration of entire Indian Air Force. The Air Officer is a keen sportsman, and has a special liking towards Badminton. He likes to listen to any melodious music and watching sports on TV. The Air Officer has been commended by Vice Chief of Air Staff in 1996. For his distinguished service he has been awarded with Vishisht Seva Medal in 2011, Ati Vishisht Seva Medal in 2013 and the highest award Param Vishisht Seva Medal in 2016 by the Hon'ble President of India. Air Marshal HB Rajaram is married to Mrs Jyothi Rajaram and blessed with a daughter and a son.
