- **Improved confidence and communication skills during PI sessions.**
- **Better understanding of interview expectations and effective response techniques.**

• **Enhanced ability to present ideas clearly and participate constructively in group discussions.**

• **Increased awareness of professional etiquette and placement readiness skills.**

Student Engagement:

The sessions were highly participatory, students actively participated and gave their best during mock PI and also got few inputs as feedback.

Take away of the session:

Students gained practical experience in participating in facing interviews, improved their confidence and articulation skills, and developed better clarity on corporate expectations and placement preparedness.
