1. Objectives of the event:

- ▲ To deepen students' understanding of Environment, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles and sustainability practices in business and society.
- ▲ To sensitize students about social challenges and prepare them for meaningful engagement during the two-week Social Immersion Program.
- ▲ To equip students with the mindset, analytical skills, and practical exposure required to evaluate and contribute to social impact initiatives.

2. Event Details

a. Brief description of the event:

A two-day Environment, Social & Governance (ESG) Student Development Program was organized for the 2024–26 batch. The program brought together students from all three sections, fostering collaborative and interdisciplinary learning. The initiative aimed to build a strong foundation in sustainability and responsible business practices. The sessions were designed to be interactive and included discussions, case studies, and experiential learning activities.

Students explored key environmental concerns, social equity issues, and governance frameworks relevant to contemporary organizations. Special emphasis was placed on understanding the role of businesses in addressing societal challenges. Participants conducted detailed research on various non-governmental organizations to understand their structure, impact areas, and operational models.

The program also encouraged critical thinking about ethical leadership and sustainable decision-making. It served as a preparatory platform for RVIM's mandatory two-week social immersion requirement. The event was conducted in collaboration with LetsTagOn, an organization dedicated to empowering youth through structured social impact opportunities.

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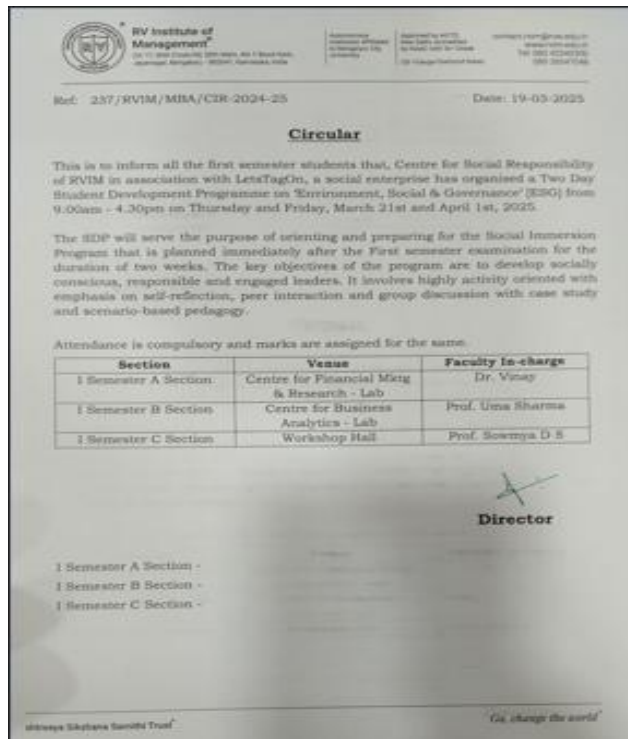

f. Outcome attained

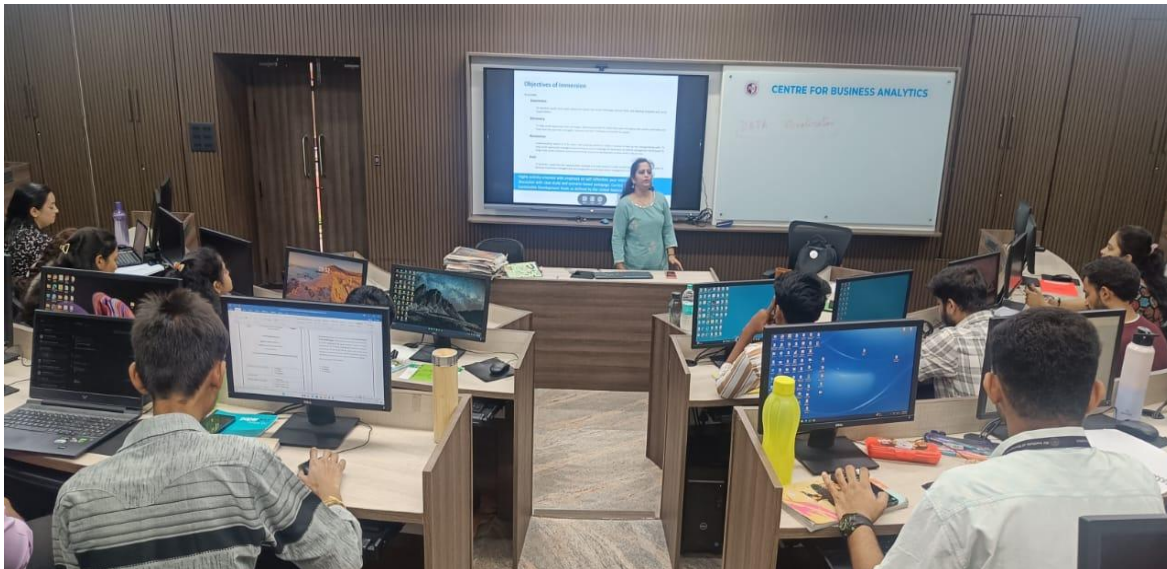
