All students enrolled and participated have appreciated the training session as a learning session.

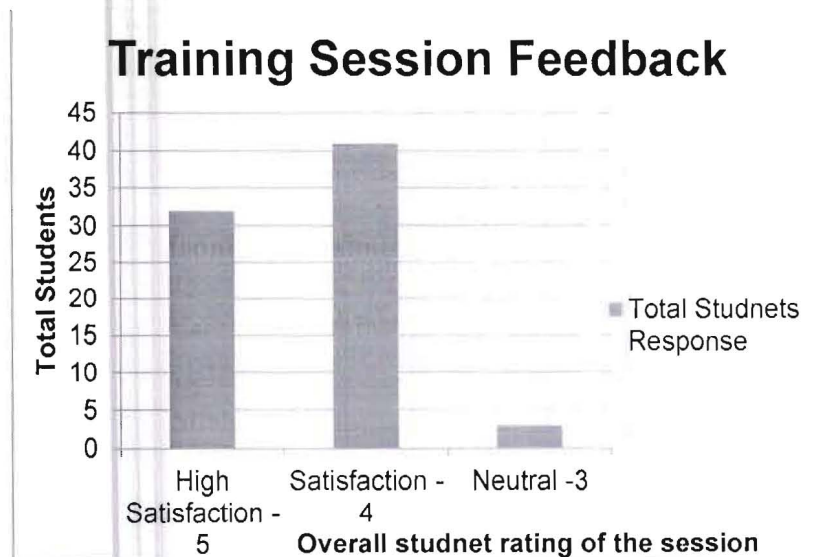
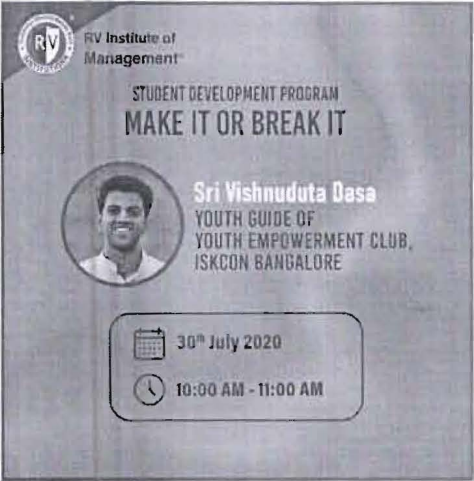
