

### Memorandum of Understanding

TopXight Research Labs (India) Pvt. Ltd. on behalf of ALPHABETA INC (a TOPXIGHT Labs company) is pleased to announce the partnership with the **RV Institute of Management**, **Bangalore**, to promote ALPHABETA run courses among the students at scale. The primary responsibilities, agreement details and proposal plan that will constitute a part of this agreement are detailed below.

The MoU is valid for a period of 3 years from the date of signing.

### Description

Course: Introduction to Investing & Equity Portfolio Management (Certified by ALPHABETA): This course will enable students to learn about the basics of portfolio management.

- a. Topics covered:
  - Covering asset classes- Stocks, Bonds, Commodities (covering Gold), measuring performance- Risk, Return, Alpha, Goal based investing etc
  - ii. Introduction to Passive investing (Exchange Traded Funds)
  - iii. Introduction to Active Management (Stocks, Mutual Funds)
  - Actual Investment Strategies used by fund managers, investment banks
  - v. Factor based investing with Momentum, Value, Volatility and size considerations
  - vi. Pairs Trading (Relative value arbitrage)
  - vii. Build portfolio and compete with peers on near real time basis
- b. The concepts that the participants learn as a part of these programs are used by leading real-world Portfolio/Fund managers. The participants will understand how leading portfolio managers base their decisions grounded on strong academic theory and research.
- c. The objective of the course, and of ALPHABETA as a platform, is to connect this theory to practice. The participants in the program will start with simple concepts and graduate progressively to more complex strategies using both statistical and fundamental methods. At the end of the course, participants will be able to



confidently articulate about portfolio management concepts and leading strategies deployed by the Portfolio Managers.

## **Course Delivery**

The course will be delivered by faculty of RVIM, with appropriate training provided by TOPXIGHT team, to enable RVIM to independently deliver the curriculum.

ALPHABETA personnel will spend 3 days training the faculty on campus, additionally live-interactive webinar sessions with ALPHABETA accredited mentors can be arranged based on need.

### Course Prerequisites

Prerequisites for the program are basic mathematical and reasoning skills, along with a healthy mix of curiosity and enthusiasm, without the fear of failing! Students from all years and fields of study are eligible. Investment management courses have a gradual learning curve. Once you are familiar with the basic learning topics, it'll be very easy to understand and apply the more advanced concepts.

As a prerequisite, high school level mathematics and reasoning skills are required. Basic knowledge of finance and accounting will be an added advantage.

#### Course Goals

Using the highly interactive ALPHABETA app, the learning is driven by lab experiments that allow participants to visualize stocks, learn concepts, make decisions, and create trades like a portfolio manager.

### **Participant Learning Objectives**

The basic concepts of finance and trading are bundled as modules which have one or more sessions.

- For each session, participants will have supplementary access to a video lecture, a lab experiment, a presentation supplement, and a quiz. Each session, participants will learn one new concept in each category and apply them in the corresponding lab experiment on the ALPHABETA App.
- 2. At the end of each module, the participant will have an assignment that will be heavily based on the lab experiments, simulations, and reading & interpretation of the academic papers for additional credit. Learning session will be group concepts as:
  - a. Analytical based on finance theory
  - b. Quantitative based on math, and
  - c. Heuristic based on best practice acquired through repetition



 From start of the course, the participants will start managing a virtual portfolio and participate in an equity trading competition measuring their performance on various parameters as will be outlined in the first session

#### Course Duration

Introduction to Investing & Equity Portfolio Management (7 weeks, Delivered by faculty of RVIM)

Students will have permanent access to Learn and Simulate mode on the ALPHABETA-guide App and Compete mode for 52 weeks from the start date.

Batches start September 2020.

# The following are included as a part of the course-

- 1. ALPHABETA League (contingent upon min batch of 20 students): The equity trading competition (the ALPHABETA League) will start 3 weeks into the course. Students who have enrolled in the course will be eligible to participate in the competition and build their own, individual virtual trading portfolios. The competition will run for a period of 3 months, at the end of which, 3 winners will be chosen and certificate of merit will be awarded to them. Students need to show active engagement to be eligible by making at least one trade per month in the virtual portfolio. The winners will be based ALPHABETA Rank, which is based on the risk adjusted return and alpha performance of the portfolio created by students. The Leaderboard will be transparent updated on a real-time basis.
- Digital certificates will be issued for each of the courses based on final grades (as calculated above). Students who do not qualify will not be eligible for the certificate.

We look forward to bringing the power of Active learning and Augmented Intelligence at one of the most prestigious institutes in the country and believe that this will help learners build careers in the area of investment management.
