Parameters for SWOT Analysis

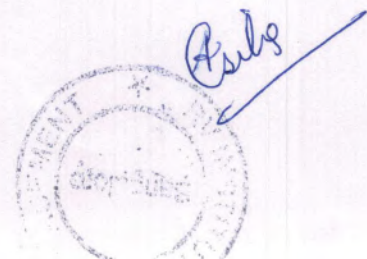
1. Strengths
