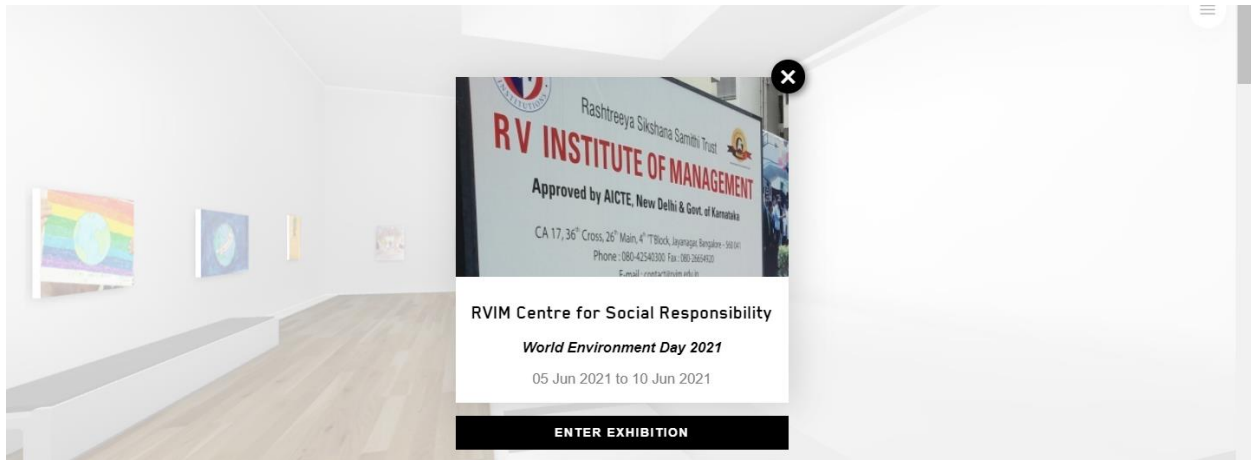

03 Contents and Artworks

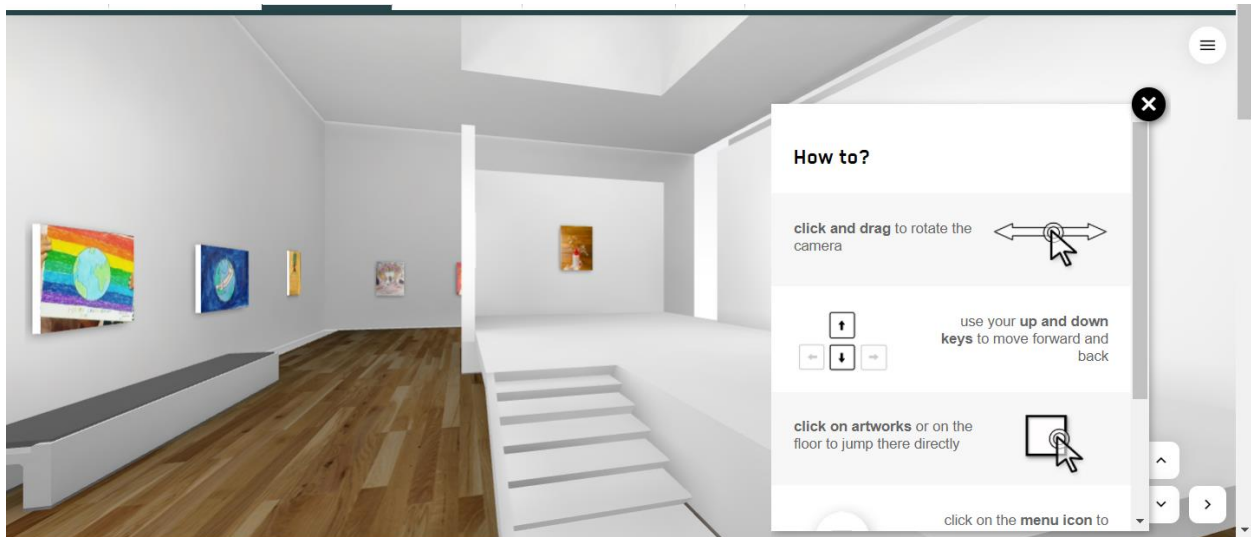
Contents

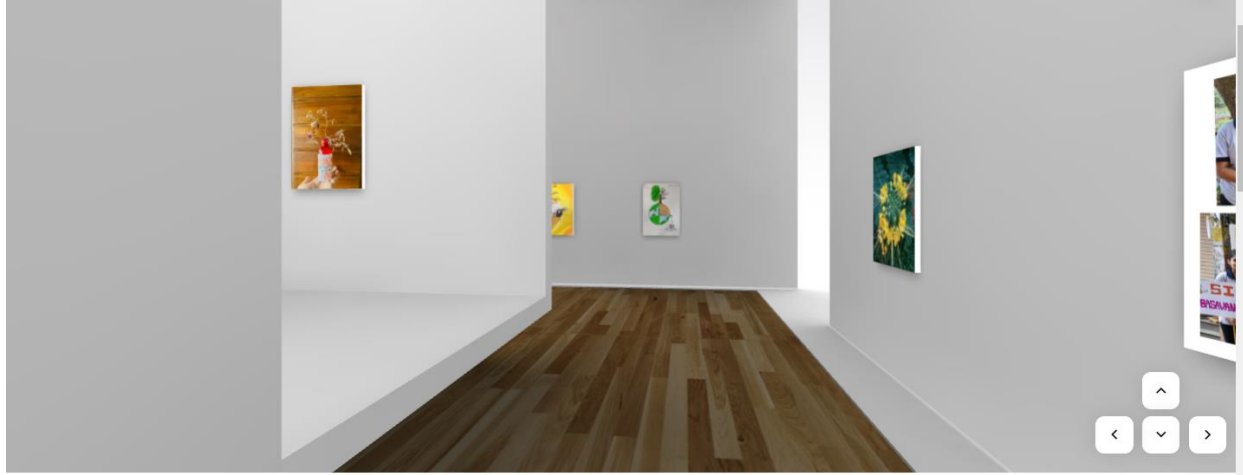
Main Landing Page to Enter Exhibition



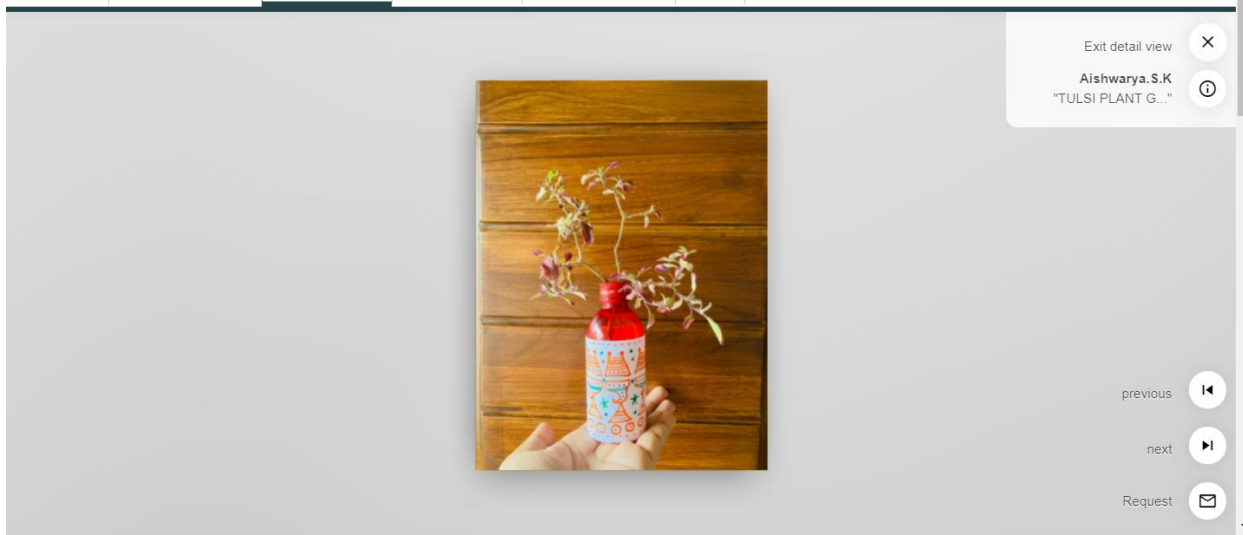
Exhibition Navigation Control

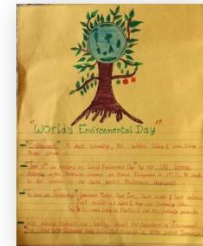

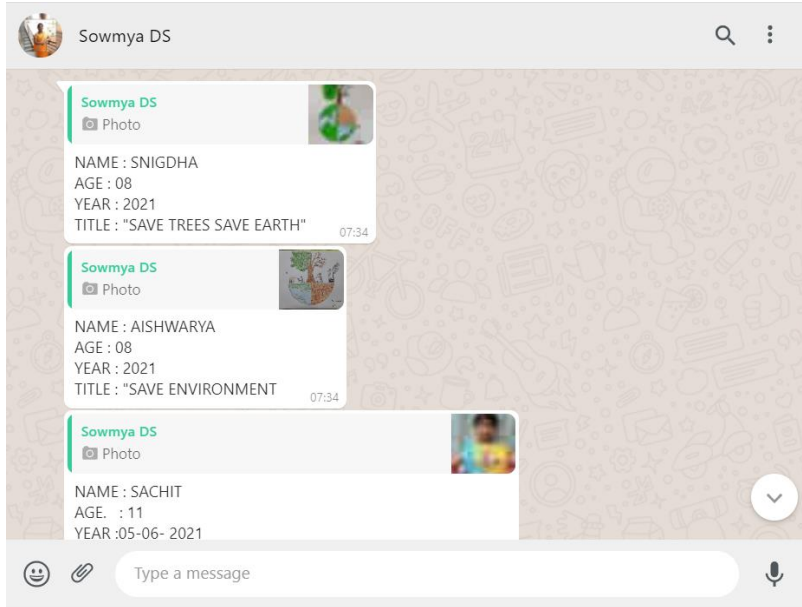
