

For the days programme and to throw light on the blending feminist philosophy and research with mindfulness leadership models and creative processes to empower women to access their deepest calling and make their highest contribution in any area of life, a panel discussion among the eminent women of our society was done at the institute.

Traditionally in Indian society the position of women has been pitiable in all the aspects of her life and her subjugation by males has been a matter of fact. She could not feel independent and act so barring a few expectations. Even today, the struggle for establishing her independent identity is being pursued with more vigour.

In the present scenario, a movement is being launched as a hope of success. Indian women are becoming more and more conscious of their constitutional and statutory rights. This consciousness has awakened in them a sense of urgency in experiencing equality and social justice. Without equality and social justice there cannot be democracy in the real sense.

She can put herself into a distance from her environment; think ahead in creating mental images of the future as it should be for her and act on nature to rebuild her life and surroundings.


1. Jyoti Pahadsingh


