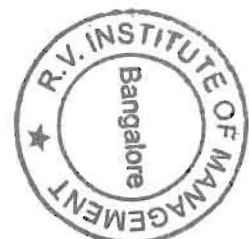

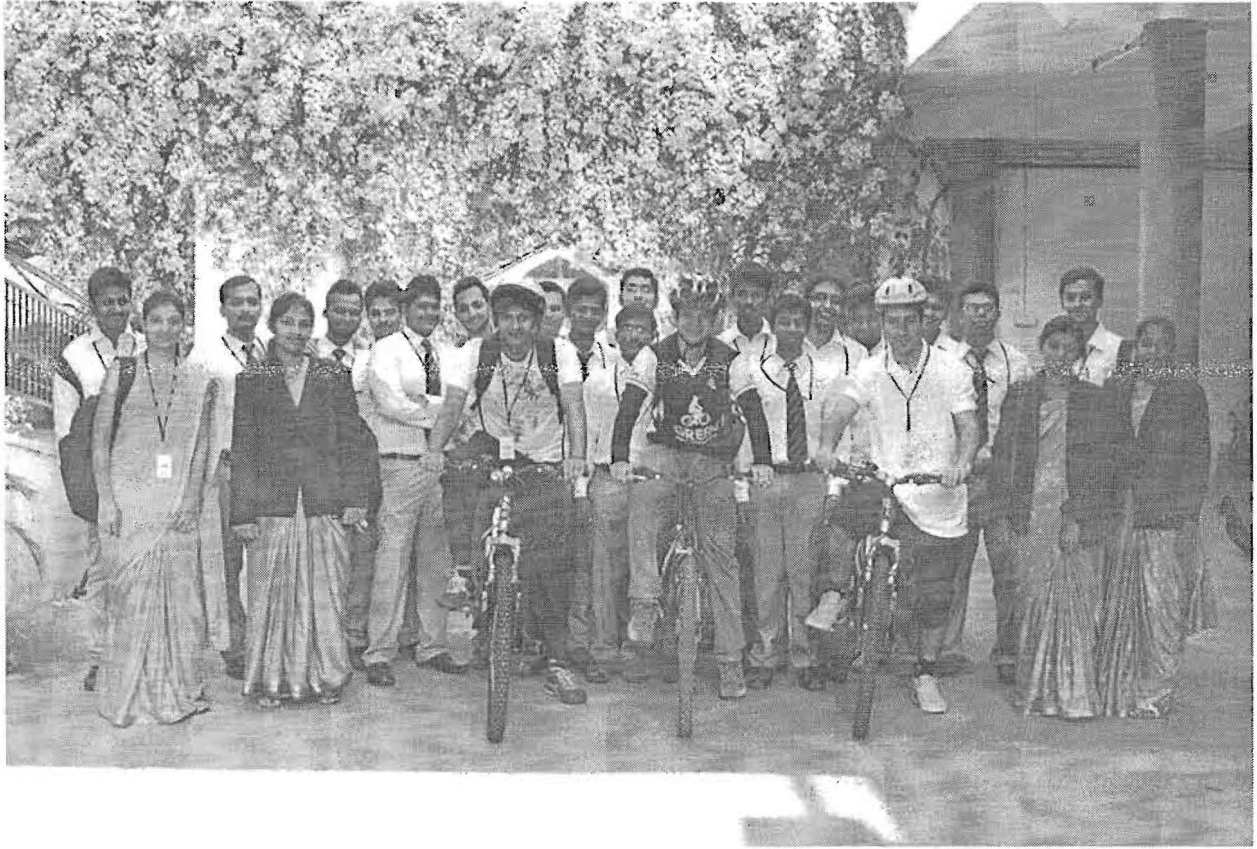
World Environment Day 2014

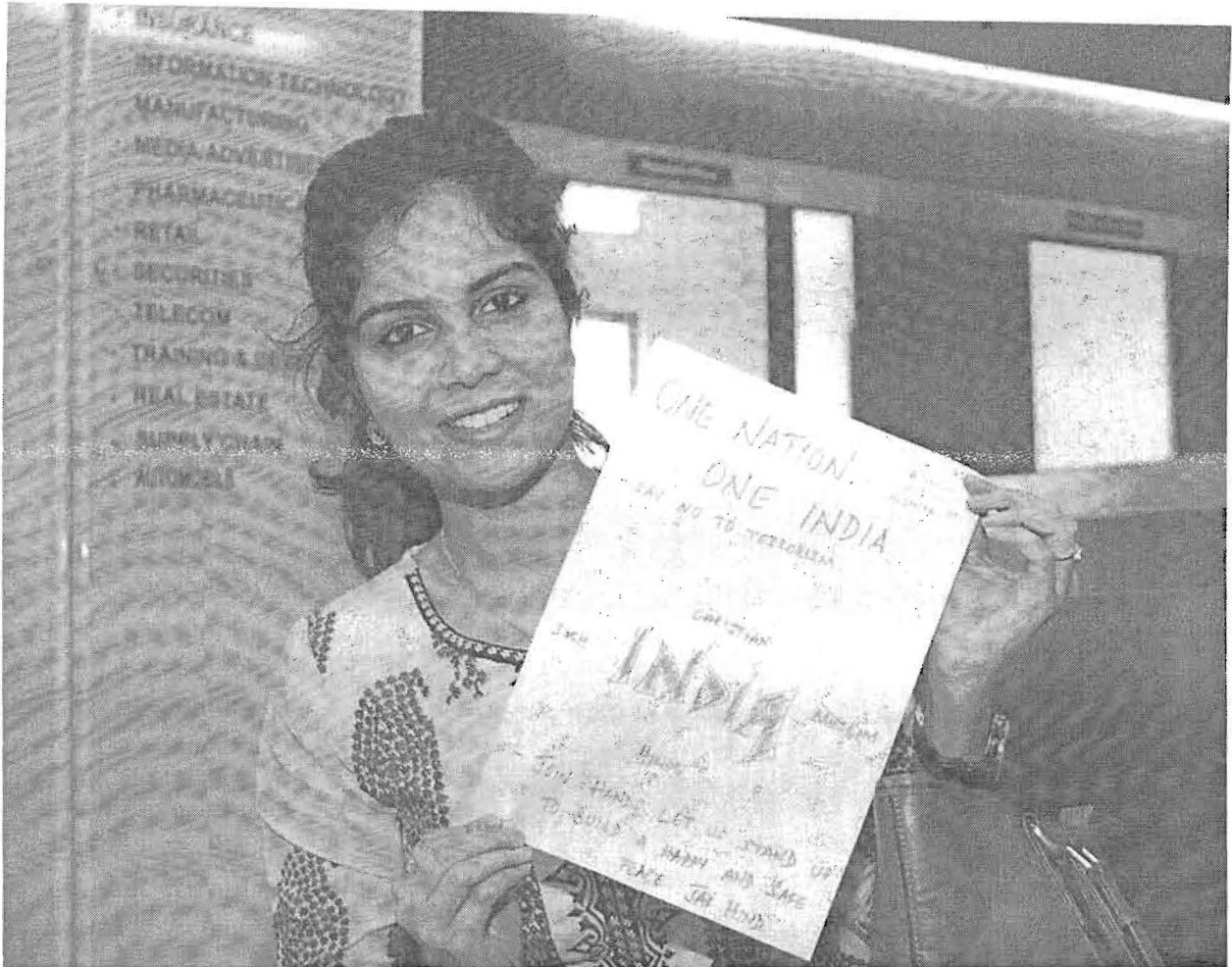
