

Green Audit at RVIM

Green Audit refers to official examination of the effects of the organization on the environment, especially in measuring the damage caused to the ecology.

RVIM is predominantly an academic institution and the scope of the audit limits to the campus environment and the people footprints. The people group formed is faculty, students and visitors. The material coverage shall include papers, covers, plastic and metal stationeries, calculators, computer laptops and food containers and accessories for materials carriage to name a few. The food and pantry utensils are audited to provide a usage pattern. Few important aspects of health and medical disposals of the Health Room/Sick Room are also made.

The areas of present audit coverage is :

- Waste minimization and recycling
- Greening the environment
- Animal welfare
- Water conservation
- Energy conservation

Carbon footprint calculator is used to measure an estimate of how many tons of carbon dioxide and other green house gasses are created each year.

The use Calculator of Santa Clara University, Markkula Centre for Applied Ethics is done to arrive at the consumption pattern and equation of transportation vehicles, mobile phones and I pods.

The student volunteers of Centre for Social Responsibility in RVIM Campus are utilized for basic assessment purpose and to sensitize the students on various issues of Green Audit. The audit is Internal Audit.

Preliminary observations and recordings

- There is enough natural lighting across II and III Floor.
- Few curtains need to be slide opened to receive more light. The student volunteers of that class shall be informed to carry out this job.
- The common switches for tube light are identified. Students to be informed to keep this switch OFF during day light. The Volunteers shall take responsibility to create poster instruction in all such places.
- Toilets shall have energy and water conservation posters .The responsibility shall be taken by students.
- Every student shall be informed regarding their responsibility to keep the lighting and fan switches OFF when not required.
- Most of the responses in the student questionnaire for Green Audit are indicating good initiatives adopted. A good number of students preferred to walk to campus rather than using a vehicle. There seems a tendency among I Semester students to opt cycling for reaching the campus. How ever this number is very small.
